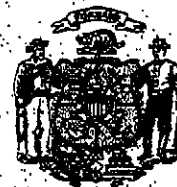

Brief Facts of Accident/Loss:

ON OCTOBER 11, 2006, APPROXIMATELY 11:00 PM, SEVERAL POLICE OFFICERS ARRIVED AT OUR HOME DEMANDING WE OPEN THE DOOR, WE THOUGHT SOMEONE CALLED FOR THEM BUT THEY HAD THE WRONG ADDRESS SO WE INFORMED THEM THAT NO ONE IN OUR HOUSE HAD PHONED FOR POLICE. AGAIN THEY INSISTED WE OPEN THE DOOR, WE ASKED WHY, AFTER SEVERAL MINUTES THEY REPLIED WE LIKE FOR YOU TO TAKE A LOOK AT THIS PICTURE, WE ASKED WHY WERE SO MANY OFFICERS FOR SOMEONE TO SHOW US A PICTURE, THEY REFUSED TO EXPLAIN SO WE ASKED WHICH PRECINCT THEY WERE FROM SO WE COULD CALL AND VERIFY, REPLY WAS "WE NOT FROM A PRECINCT" WE ASKED "WHERE IS YOUR SERGEANT AND REPLY, "JUST OPEN THE DOOR." THEY DID SOMETHING TO OUR SATELLITE DISH WHICH CAUSE US TO HAVE TO PLACE SERVICE CALL TO RESTORE OUR CABLE. ON OCTOBER 12, 2006 POLICEMEN ARRIVED AT OUR HOME AGAIN, BUT ON THIS DAY THEY ARRESTED ME FOR COMMITMENT FROM "94" SO THEY STATED: I TRIED TO EXPLAIN TO THEM THAT I DIDN'T HAVE ANYTHING (NO TICKETS OUTSTANDING) WHICH WOULD SECURE COMMITMENT. I WASN'T AT MY HOME, I WAS DOWN THE STREET WITH FRIENDS AT THEIR HOME, WHICH IS WHERE THE POLICES HAD PARKED THEIR VEHICLES, SO I NOTICE THEY WERE WALKING TOWARD MY HOUSE AGAIN. THEY TOLD ME TO GET ON THE GROUND, I TOLD THEM THAT I LIVE HERE, BUT THEY TOLD ME THEY SAW ME COME FROM HOUSE DOWN THE STREET AND ASKED ME FOR MY ID. AFTER CHECKING MY ID THEY TOLD ME THAT I WAS UNDER ARREST.

**Brief Facts of Accident/Loss:**

I ASKED WHAT WERE THE CHARGES "94" WARRANT FOR COMMITMENT. THEY REFUSED TO ALLOW ME TO  
CALL MY FAMILY FROM MY CELL PHONE OR JUST RING MY DOORBELL SO I COULD INFORM MY FAMILY OF MY  
WHERE ABOUT. THEY ARRESTED ME AND TOOK ME TO THE COUNTY JAIL. MY KEYS WERE TAKEN FROM MY PROPERTY  
BEFORE I WAS LOCKED IN A CELL. I ASKED WHERE ARE MY KEYS, THEY TOLD ME IN THE PLASTIC BAG, I TOLD  
THEM I DON'T SEE THEM AND THEY TOLD ME TO SHUT UP. MY WIFE TOLD ME THE POLICE UNLOCKED THE  
DOWN STAIRS (Duplex) DOOR AND ENTER AND CAME UPSTAIRS TO OUR DOOR. SHE HEARD SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO GET INSID  
UR HOME, BUT SHE THOUGHT IT WAS ME SINCE SHE HEARD THE KEYS AND NO ONE HAD RUNG THE DOORBELL. I HAD  
PHONE HER WHEN THE POLICE ARRIVED AND TOLD HER I WAS ON MY WAY TO THE HOUSE. SHE DIDN'T HEAR FROM ME  
GAIN UNTIL FRIDAY, 10/13/06, APPROX. 9-10 AM. MY FAMILY WAS VERY WORRIED BECAUSE I DIDN'T HAVE MY MEDICINE  
OR HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE. MY WIFE ALSO TOLD ME ~~THE~~ THE OFFICER GAVE HER MY HOUSE KEYS AND TOLD HER  
THAT I WAS STILL DOWN THE STREET WATCHING THE GAME BUT I WAS IN JAIL AT THAT TIME AND THEY HAD MY  
KEYS. MISLEADING MY FAMILY TO BELIEVE I HAD GIVEN THEM THE KEYS TO GIVE TO HER, SHE THOUGHT THAT WAS  
STRANGE BUT DIDN'T QUESTION THEM BECAUSE AS FAR AS THEY KNEW I WAS DOWN THE STREET, THE LAST LOCATION THE

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To Mr. Albert Taylor:



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
