
Dear Mr. Ragland Jr:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, November 10, 2015, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses be renewed with a ten (10) day suspension for the premises located at 5219 W Hampton Ave ("Comments Lounge") based upon the police report, neighborhood testimony and applicant testimony.

On November 13, 2015, you were mailed true and correct copies of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the renewal applications for your Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses, in which the Committee recommended that the licenses be renewed with a ten day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, November 24, 2015, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Licenses Committee to renew the Class "B" Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses with a ten (10) day suspension based on the police report, neighborhood testimony and applicant testimony. Said suspension is to be in effect between 12:01 a.m. on December 17, 2015 through 11:59 p.m., December 27, 2015.


Dear Mr. Yeager:
