Dear Council Members:

The 2006 Capital Improvement Program includes the improvement of South 20th Street from West Grange Avenue to West Layton Avenue under the Surface Transportation Program. The Federal Program provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

Eighty percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT). The local share, \$6,903.93, will be provided through the Division's existing Capital Improvement Program.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Local Forces Account – Local contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the improvement of South 20 Street from West Grange Avenue to West Layton Avenue in the 13th Aldermanic District.
