Mr. Gerald Glazer, a long time resident of Sherman Park brought a very good idea to me, and consequently, I would like to request that the one-way city street, running in a U-shape around Gengler Park, be renamed Gengler Way. It is currently named 50th St.

As now marked, it confuses drivers attempting to get to 50th Street from Burleigh Street. Immediately north of Burleigh, 50th Street is a one-way street south. In addition to owning Gengler Park (around which the future Gengler Way would run), St. Joseph Regional Medical Center owns the Healing Garden to the west and the out lot to the west. There are no other property owners on this section of the street.

I rough diagram of the location is attached for reference.

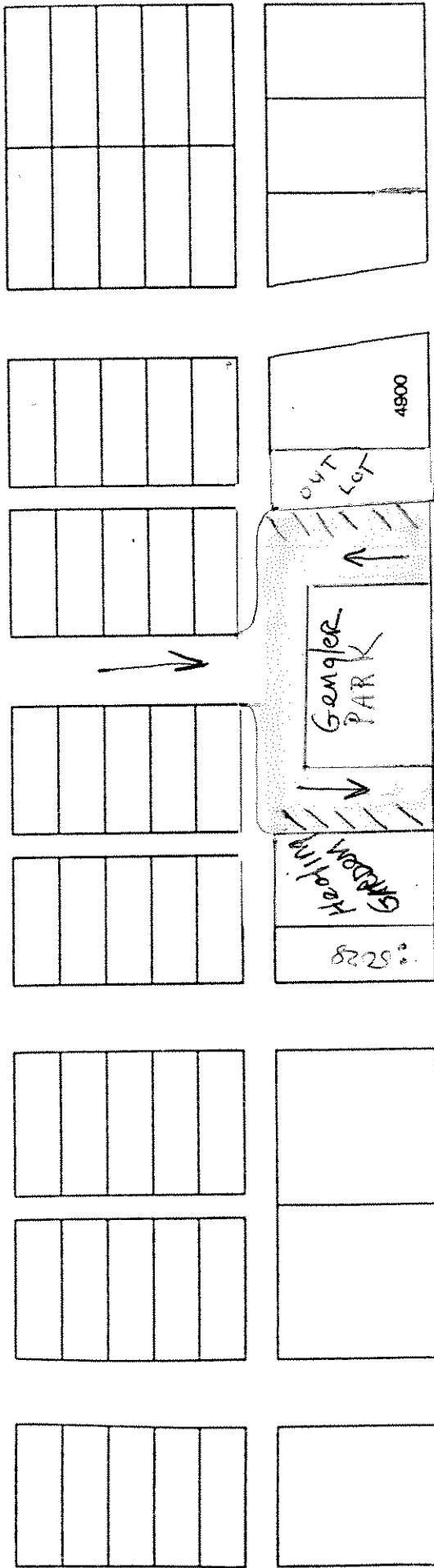

ST. JOSEPH'S HOSPITAL PROPERTIES

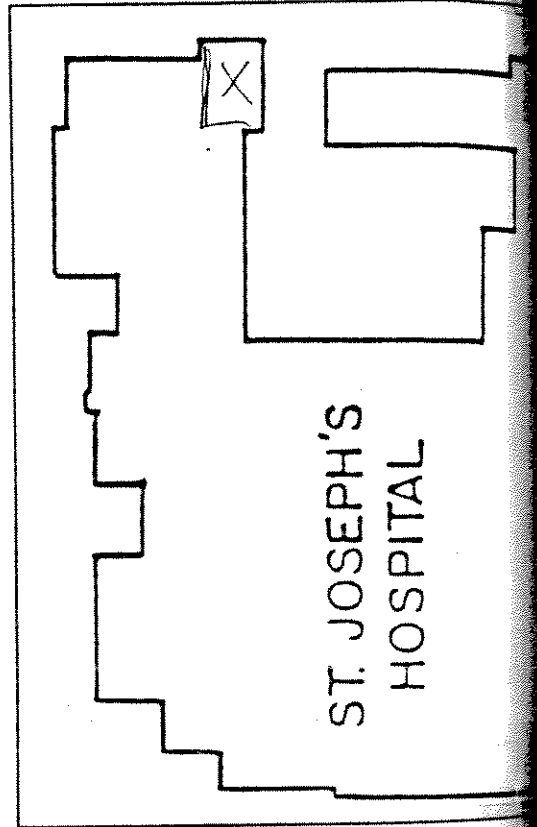
● = NUMBER OF UNITS

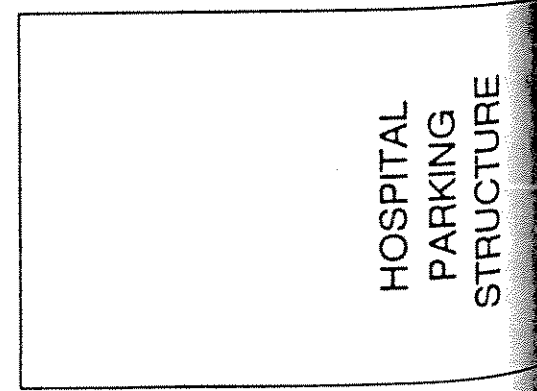
