Item 2

Amending the Tax Levy for the 2006 Fiscal Year

RESOLVED, by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage Commission, that the tax levy for the 2006 fiscal year is amended to reflect the following:

- a. \$24,955,000 for debt service coming due in 2006 on outstanding general obligations of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (for which a non-repealable direct annual tax has previously been levied by the Commission) less amounts recorded in the debt service fund created for the general obligation bonds; and
- b. \$41,586,000 for debt service coming due in 2006 on outstanding general obligations of the District that were sold to the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund Program (for which a non-repealable direct annual tax has previously been levied by the Commission) less amounts recorded in the debt service fund created for the general obligation bonds; and
- c. \$1,684,000 for debt service coming due in 2006 on new anticipated general obligations of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District to be sold to the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund Program; and
- d. \$7,975,000 to finance a portion of the 2006 fiscal year capital budget;

totaling \$76,200,000 shall be carried on to the tax roll of each city, town or village wholly or partially within the boundaries of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District and collected in addition to all other taxes and in the same manner and at the same time, all as provided by law.
