The rear passenger runs after the subject. The subject then comes back, enters the car, the driver exits the store and the car drives off.

This report is written by P.O. Reginald Carthen district seven day shift squad 7120. On 06/21/2016 at about 3:30PM I, was dispatched 7800 W. Appleton Ave. for a shooting. Upon arriving I, spoke with HAMMAD, HASAN M. i/m 11/22/72 4126 W. College Ave. Greenfield WI. 53221 (262)321-9603 who stated there were two black males shooting in the parkinglot. He stated that he works at H&I FOODS. HASAN stated that he has it on camera. He then replayed the video for me. Upon watching the video I observed a green vehicle pull into the lot, and driver gets out and goes inside of the store. While in the store you can see he has a female passenger and a rear passenger also. The rear passenger opens his door but does not get out of the vehicle. Short time later you see a another black male walk up Appleton Ave. to the store on the Westside. This male enters the store, but a short time later he exits the store and walks over to the green vehicle. He walks up to the rear passenger who had the door open, and punches him as he is sitting in the vehicle. You can see this male pull a gun from his waist area, and now he and the male seated in the vehicle are argueing. A few minutes later you see the male who is standing outside of the vehicle jump, and take off running towards the direction he walked up from. As he is running away you see the male that was sitting inside of the vehicle get out and point his gun at the male that's running away. You then see the male that ran stop near a vehicle, and start firing shots back in the direction of the male that was sitting in the vehicle. After firing shots the male runs off Northbound on W. Appleton Ave. and then Eastbound behind the store. The other male that was sitting in the vehicle looked as if his gun jammed. He then is seen running Eastbound in the parkinglot. A short time later he returns and gets back into the vehicle at which time the driver comes out of the store and gets in and they leave Eastbound on W. Congress Ave.

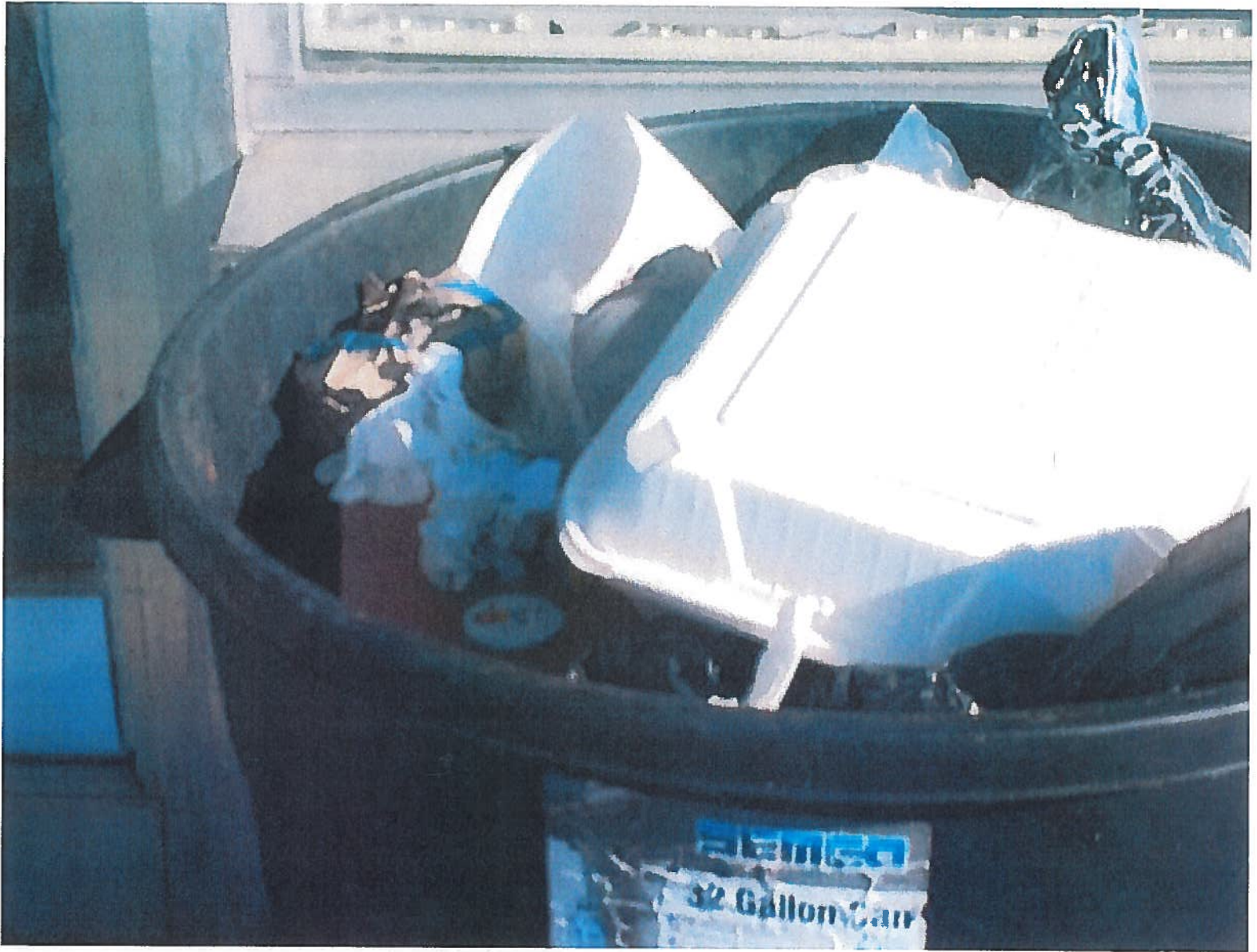

DR I understand that every item exchanged or purchased or accepted on consignment must be kept on the dealer's premises separate and apart from any other property, unchanged and unaltered, for 30 days for inspection by the police department; additional holding periods may be requested by the department.
- 7. DR I understand that the police may extend the holding period if there is reason to believe that the item purchased or exchanged was not sold or exchanged by the rightful owner.
- 8. DR I understand that no transactions may be conducted with a minor less than 18 years of age unless the minor is with a parent or guardian, or the dealer has a written consent on file signed in the dealer's presence by the parent or guardian.
- 9. DR I understand that no transactions may be conducted with any intoxicated person.
- 10. DR I understand every pawnbroker must report to the police department any item presented in the course of business if there is reason to believe the item was stolen.
