

Hartung Quarry Park

Conceptual Development Plan and Proposed Site Features

- Play / Exercise Experience with New Alternative Play Equipment, a Silurian Reef Interpretive Outcropping, and Oversized Fossils for Informal Seating or Climbing.
- A Paved Path for accessibility to use area of Labyrinth / Amphitheater.
- Multiple Unpaved Trails (Mowed or Wood Chip) for Walking, Nature Hiking, or Cross-country Ski.
- Recreated Limestone Outcroppings Create 3 Overlooks with Scenic Vistas.
- Natural Amphitheater Created with Large Limestone Outcroppings creating informal seating around Limestone Labyrinth in Lawn.
- Multi-Purpose Play Field
- Sledding Hill
- Native Woodland and Woodland Edge Plantings
- Short-Prairie Meadow Plantings
- Infiltration Basins / Rain Garden Demonstration to contain Stormwater Runoff.
- Primary Public Access from Menomonee River Parkway.
- Safe Cross walk across Menomonee River Parkway to link to future Paved Oakleaf Trail and existing Rest rooms.
- Potentially 7 Lots similar in size to surrounding neighborhood could be sold to raise money for plan implementation.
