Dear Mr. Carini:

After reviewing the correspondence sent to me, I have some questions regarding this letter.

1. On July 11, 2017 the temp at the time of this incident was 80 degrees.
2. Wind speed 5 mph (SE). My car was parked in front of 5865 N. 72nd street, which is (NW). Max wind was 15 mph which was listed online for Milwaukee on this date. Not the 17 mph (gust) as mentioned in this letter. We were moving if you look at the photos sent the leaves on the trees do not look like they were being blown by a 17 mph wind gust.
3. The sentence stating the Forestry crew leader (no name given) found that the branch was not blocking the area. What branch did this person see and move the next day. The branch in the photo was moved the same day. After we heard glass breaking, photos were taken and then we started to clean up the glass and put the branch in the garbage. Something is not adding up here.
4. You indicated for the last six (6) years that the trees in this area are on a regular pruning schedule and were last pruned in March 2017. The weather in March 2017 was not conducive to any pruning as you can see from the information listed below:



I want another review of my claim.



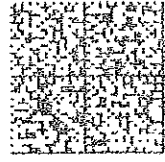
