#### **Purpose of Amendment:**

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the contract term for one (1) year, from 03/01/2025 through 02/28/2026 by exercising the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) of two (2) options to extend and to increase the contract total by \$457,203.89 from \$818,629.89 to \$1,275,833.78. The operating funds being added to the contract represent the annual management fee and costs for personnel, benefits and insurance for the requested contract term extension. Vendor contract services for in-house medical assessment and patient care has reduced the number of medical runs required by the Milwaukee Police Department. The reduction of each medical run for those that are incarcerated frees up approximately three (3) hours of time, enabling officers to focus on policing services rather than transporting those in need of medical services to area hospitals.

#### Background:

Wellpath, LLC works with the Milwaukee Police Department to attract and retain healthcare professionals to provide quality care for individuals being held in custody. Their healthcare staff are available for on-site professional support, 24/7 on call support, laboratory, x-ray, and pharmacy services. Wellpath, LLC specializes
