This resolution would allow the Milwaukee Fire Department to accept donations up to \$650,000 from citizens, foundations and other entities in support of the Project Staying Alive program; a program operated in collaboration with the Milwaukee Public Schools. Specifically, Milwaukee Children's Hospital and Milwaukee Public Schools offered donation of \$3,148 and \$100,000, respectively to train firefighters on the program and purchase supplies.
