---\$413.08 claim related to a forced entry into a private residence by the police

department. The officers took appropriate action and, as such, the City is not liable.

---\$39,509.73 claim related to a collision between a private vehicle and a police vehicle. The officer acted appropriately and was in lawful pursuit of a third vehicle, so the City cannot be held liable.

8. [051527](#) Resolution relating to a claim from Atty. Paul Beard on behalf of Will Sherard, d/b/a/ WJ Sherard Realty Co. for loss of income and damages.

---\$7,844 claim related to loss of rental income based upon the city's deeming a property as unfit for human habitation. The City departments followed their standard procedures and the City cannot be held liable.

---\$1,429.36 claim related to damage to a private vehicle which was towed by the City. Video shows that the vehicle was damaged prior to the tow.
