**1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations)**

The purpose of the program is to expand the capacity of the Milwaukee Fire Education Center (Survive Alive House) to provide fire prevention, safety and education services in the City of Milwaukee. Services would be available to all City of Milwaukee residents as well as residents of neighboring suburbs. This grant would allow for the purchase of additional educational materials, equipment upgrades, minor facility renovations and a feasibility study to create an additional Survive Alive House site in either the far west or far north section of the city.

**2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:**

Strategic Goal: Protect Milwaukee's citizens from crime, fire and other hazards.  
 Strategy 7: Reduce the damage caused by fires and other catastrophes that do occur.

This grant is related to the above Public Safety Strategies and Actions as well as the department's objective to provide timely fire and emergency services (including responding to terrorist threats and/or assaults) to make the city a safe place to live, work and conduct business. The \$200,000 that this grant would fund will expand the capacity of the Milwaukee Fire Department to provide fire prevention, safety and education to the greater Milwaukee community.

**3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs)**

This grant will provide funding for the replacement of aging equipment utilized daily in the facility, roof repair, upgrading of machinery and interactive audio/visual equipment. Newer supplies and equipment will assist the department to train and analyze the approaches, methods and practices to keep children and other targeted populations safe in the event of fires or national emergencies.
