This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,317.59, relating to damage sustained to your 2000 Ford on January 6, 2001.

The Sanitation Division records indicate the sanitation supervisor saw a line on your vehicle that appeared as though something had rubbed against it. He, however, observed no real damage to the truck. The crew denies causing any damage to your vehicle. Therefore in absence of proof to the contrary, we must take credence in the testimony of the sanitation crew and not accept liability in this matter. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision you may do by sending a letter within 21 days of receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
