Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.04

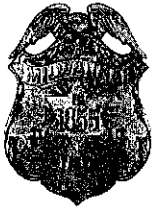
Core Value 5.00 – Respect, referencing Guiding Principle 5.03

PERSONNEL ORDER 2019 - 145

RE: DISCIPLINARY ACTION

POLICE OFFICER LUKE X. LEE, (017099), Fourth District, charged with violation of department Code of Conduct as follows:

Core Value 1.00 – Competence, referencing Guiding Principle 1.04: Failure to complete reports in a prompt and thorough manner.

Core Value 5.00 - Respect, referencing Guiding Principle 5.03: Failure to promptly obey a proper and lawful order from an officer of a higher rank.

The charge having been substantiated, he is found guilty as charged and the penalty adjudged appropriate by the Chief of Police is as follows:

Failure to complete reports in a prompt and thorough manner.

Four (4) day suspension without pay.

Failure to promptly obey a proper and lawful order from an officer of a higher rank.

Ten (10) day suspension without pay.

It is hereby ordered that POLICE OFFICER LUKE X. LEE be suspended a total of fourteen (14) working days without pay. If not appealed, said suspension shall be served during the following periods: November 10, 2019 through November 21, 2019; and December 15, 2019 through December 21, 2019.
