Communication from the Milwaukee Police Department relating to its use of asset forfeiture funds for neighborhood initiatives as provided in Common Council File Number 161720.

- On July 7, 2017, the Chief Flynn's administration committed \$35,000 toward "neighborhood initiatives" from the federal asset forfeiture fund
 - Not aware of any purchases made pursuant to this commitment
- Assistant Chief Brunson reached out to every district captain to obtain neighborhood feedback:
 - Main feedback:
 - Food for events (i.e. block parties, national night out)
 - Prohibited by asset forfeiture rules
 - "Ring" cameras
 - MPD reached out to asset forfeiture regulators; request denied
 - Speeding
