On February 15, 2003 the Milwaukee Water Works sent an employee to my home (3439 S. New York Ave.) to replace my water meter. The Water Works employee failed to turn the water off prior to beginning work and broke the water pipe off in the floor. The employee did not know how to shut the water off at the street and went out to his truck while my basement was filling with water. Twenty minutes later five additional members of the water department showed up, including his supervisor, Art Davies. One of these members located and turned off the water at the street. They continued with the water meter replacement and when confronted with the damage and cleanup of my basement, I was told that it was my problem and that I should contact the City Clerks office to file a claim. They called in a plumber to replace the pipe broken off by the Water Works employee. The plumber could not believe that the Water Works employee had not shut off and did not know how to shut off the water prior to beginning work.

As a result of the negligence of the Milwaukee Water Works I have incurred the following damages;
