1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The goal of the project is to reduce violent crimes and violence in urban areas using interagency collaboration and culturally competent proactive strategies that increase protective factors and decrease risk factors. In order to achieve this goal, the project aims to improve the availability and quality of interdisciplinary data through the creation of a sustainable data repository. The project targets organizations and systems and aims to improve the availability of interdisciplinary data to problem solve and address the problem of violence. Partner agencies will participate in every aspect of the project to ensure the data repository is useful to practitioners. Community residents are involved in MHRC's work and will be engaged to help understand the data findings, participate in discussions to coordinate services, and assess the results of the project from the perspective of the neighborhood.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The Community Safety Data Repository Project and subsequent activity will assist the Commission and its member agencies to fulfill the legislative mandate of the Common Council to "increase safety for victims of domestic violence and their children and victims of sexual assault..." The overarching goal of the site and associated services will be to protect victim safety and confidentiality and protect children from witnessing violence, being abducted, or experiencing abuse or sexual violence during visitation and exchanges.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

Funds needed to continue supporting the work of the Milwaukee Homicide Review Commission (MHRC) and the City of Milwaukee Health Departments Community Safety Data Hub project.

The final research design will include a quasi-experimental design, which will allow us to use gold standard measurement techniques such as times series analysis to assess decreases in violence/violent crimes
