Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 060089

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File 060089, being a petition from George Bockl to amend a special privilege for change of ownership for a concrete barrier free access ramp for the premises at 250 North Water Street, also known as 207 East Buffalo Street.

Permission to construct and maintain the concrete barrier free access ramp was granted in 1961 under Common Council Resolution File Number 61-2339. Said ramp projects 3 feet 8 inches into the south, 15-foot wide sidewalk area of East Buffalo Street. The ramp commences at a point approximately 88 feet east of the eastline of North Water Street and extends east 33 feet 11 inches. There is a steel pipe railing on the ramp.

We are not aware that the presence of the aforementioned ramp has had an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
