Milwaukee experiences enough violence as is, and various other bars in our vicinity have been suspended for fights and violence. We want to keep our neighborhood safe, and not see others hurt in a space that is supposed to be safe and enjoyable. The position that many neighborhood stakeholders have taken is to oppose granting the PEP license until the business has demonstrated at least 18 months of successful operation strictly as a restaurant, without nightclub activity. I hope that you are taking these concerns into consideration, as well as the past history of the individuals who have run other clubs (ELMNT / Ladybug).

Dear Members of the Milwaukee Common Council,

I am writing to formally oppose any application or approval that would permit the owners or operators of the former ELMNT Lounge, previously located at 618 N. Water Street, to relocate and reopen a nightclub operation in the Deer District area.

The City of Milwaukee already determined—after extensive review—that ELMNT Lounge posed an unacceptable risk to public safety. The revocation of its liquor license and forced closure were not discretionary actions, but the result of a documented and sustained pattern of violent incidents associated with the establishment.

By way of record:

- ELMNT Lounge accumulated a long history of police calls, disturbances, and violent incidents over multiple years.
- In December 2021, the Common Council suspended the club's license for 60 days following a fatal shooting outside the establishment.
- In 2025, violence escalated further, including:
  - A shooting in a nearby parking structure involving individuals who had patronized ELMNT earlier that evening, and
  - A July 2025 drive-by shooting directly outside the club that resulted in two fatalities and multiple injuries.
- Following these incidents, the Milwaukee Police Department formally petitioned for license revocation, citing repeated gun violence connected to the venue.
- The Licenses Committee and Common Council ultimately revoked ELMNT's liquor license, concluding that the establishment could not operate in a manner consistent with public safety.

That decision represents a clear policy judgment by the City: ELMNT Lounge, as operated by this ownership group, was not a safe or responsible business.

Allowing the same operators to simply relocate the nightclub—particularly less than one mile from its former site—would effectively undermine the City’s own findings and enforcement actions. It would shift a known risk from one neighborhood to another without addressing the underlying operational failures that led to closure.

This concern is especially acute given the proximity to the Deer District, which remains a growing and strategically important economic engine for Milwaukee. The City, the Milwaukee Bucks, and private partners have invested hundreds of millions of dollars in the Fiserv Forum, the Deer District, and surrounding mixed-use development. This area is intentionally designed as a safe, open, and family-friendly destination for residents and visitors attending NBA games, concerts, festivals, and community events.

The Deer District and adjacent neighborhoods generate significant recurring economic activity, including tourism spending, hospitality revenue, and employment opportunities. During major events, the District brings tens of thousands of visitors downtown, contributing millions of dollars annually to the local economy. Continued residential development and commercial growth depend on predictable public safety and neighborhood stability.

Introducing a nightclub with a documented history of shootings and fatalities into this environment places those investments—and the City’s long-term development strategy—at unnecessary risk.

For these reasons, I respectfully urge the City to:

1. Deny any liquor, entertainment, or related licenses associated with the former ELMNT Lounge ownership or operating group at any proposed new location near the Deer District; and
2. Apply the same public safety standards that justified the original license revocation, rather than allowing relocation to negate prior enforcement actions.

Thank you for your time and consideration. I appreciate your commitment to maintaining safe neighborhoods and protecting the significant public and private investment that continues to shape downtown Milwaukee.

Quentin GRANT assigned to "Code RED" in the 700 block of West Milwaukee Street (in full duty uniform and operating a marked MPD Squad car) were dispatched to meet Squad 1410, Sgt. Timothy GAUERKE for a Business Check complaint at the address of 714 West Milwaukee St., SAKETUMI Japanese Restaurant, which is in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I spoke with two managers regarding an Order to Cease Operations issued by the City of Milwaukee Health Department.

Interview with Manager #1, who was later identified as David Hinton (B/M, 06/22/80). HINTON stated that he was unaware that the business was to be completely closed. HINTON then provided a copy of an

inspection letter from the City of Milwaukee which stated that the SAKETUMI Japanese Restaurant section which sold food, was to be closed pending a review scheduled on May 17th, 2018. HINTON stated that he was not the head manager in charge and he would have to go upstairs to the RED BUDDHA LOUNGE to get her to come down.

Interview with Manager #2, who was later identified as Tiffany L. CAMPBELL (B/F, 08/05/83). CAMPBELL stated that and provided me with License Agent information and Bartender License of Tay NORSAVANH (B/F, 08/07/82), who I verified with a WI/DL was inside the business, which alcohol was being served. CAMPBELL also explained that the food section of this business was closed pending a review. CAMPBELL provided the same paperwork that HINTON had.

CAMPBELL stated that operations for listed date was under the "RED BUDDHA" license. CAMPBELL provided documentation showing that SAKETUME and RED BUDDHA were two separate licenses.

It was verified by. Sgt. Timothy GAUERKE, that SAKETUME Japanese Restaurant could remain open on above listed date.

## INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is typed by PO Oscar ESPITIA assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift and Squad 2572.

On Monday July 22nd, 2019 at approximately 10:30 PM my partner PO SPINATO conducted a Tavern check at 721 S. Cesar E. Chavez Dr. (Tycoon sport bar).

Upon arrival I spoke to Security guard Erico BERMUDEZ (W/M, 12/10/82). I know BERMUDEZ to be security guard of Lavish night club which is Tycoon bar now. BERMUDEZ stated Tycoon bar is owned by the same owners of Lavish but they just changed the name. He asked me to enter the bar and see the renovation of the establishment and so he could introduce me to the bar manager and "owner".

Upon entering the Tycoon bar BERMUDEZ introduced me to the bar manager who she verbally identified herself as Toyona L. HADLEY (B/F, 11/24/82). HADLEY stated she will be running the bar and bartenders. She stated all her bartenders have valid **bar tending** license and she also has a bar manager license which I confirmed via LIRA.

I then spoke to the "owner" of TYCOON sport bar, David L. HINTON (B/M, 06/22/80), who stated he is part owner. HINTON stated TYCOON is a sports bar and not a night club. HINTON stated he will be using all the license that the bar has, like for example live music. Squad 2221 (PO SMITH), responded to the scene and recovered the video footage of 07/18/20 and 07/27/20.

On the surveillance video I observed a female dancing then walks over to a group of people and hit a female in the face hit a closed fist. A group of people attempt to stop the fight but an unknown male who was carrying a satchel drop money on the floor. I observe approximately 20 to 30 people fighting over the money. He observed the male place the handgun back into his waistband and enter the vehicle. The vehicle then fled at a high rate of speed north on N Water Street.

Upon my arrival on scene I observed a .45 caliber brass casing located in the middle of the road near where OHLSSON had described the incident. I then began to interview staff of The Good Life and spoke with bouncer Lewis L GAMBLE (B/M, 02-12-83) as well as part owner David L HINTON III (B/M, 06-22-80). Both stated that there had been no incidents near the bar and neither had heard any gunshots. GAMBLE specifically stated he had been outside the bar clearing out patrons that were leaving for about 30 minutes. Please note that when I spoke with him regarding the incident it was approximately 1:50 AM.

Squad 1320, P.O. Richard BLAHA and P.O. Souri YANG, responded to the scene to take photographs of the casing and overall scene. I then recovered the brass casing and placed it on MPD Inventory # 17028387.

I observed that there was a video camera in the valet area for the business that may have captured the incident. I determined that the camera system was run by the security guard company located in the next building at 735 N Water street. While there I spoke with security guard Darrell R LINSKI (W/M, 02-04-69) who granted me access to view the surveillance cameras.

On camera D10 which was labeled GARAGE, I observed at 1:27 AM a large group of patrons exiting the bar through the valet area when a silver four door vehicle stops facing northbound. Also present outside the bar are security staff for The Good Life. I observed a subject exit the driver's door and begin to argue with security. At this time the patrons leaving begin to flee back towards the bar. I then observed the male described by OHLSSON exit the rear passenger side door and run to the driver's side and begin to argue with security. I observed the male grab a firearm from the hand of the first subject and continue to argue with security. The male then fired one round which was later discovered in the exterior wall of the building approximately 12 feet south of the valet entrance and approximately 5'5" from the sidewalk. The recovered projectile was placed on MPD inventory # 17028387.

Squad 1923, F.I. Alfonso LAZO, responded to the scene to recover video and photographs of the bullet located inside the wall. Please see his supplemental report for further detail. The surveillance video was placed on MPD inventory #17028540.

A tavern report was filed regarding this incident under tracking number 17-147.
