**Explanation:**

This plaque would honor a person, rather than a building. Donna Schlieman was a noted activist for preserving Milwaukee's historic architecture. The planned location for the plaque is a light pole that already carries a \"Donna's Way\" street-name-style sign at the top of the pole. The historic plaque will explain who Donna was. Planned wording for the plaque is: Donna Kay Schlieman (1937-2013) was a nurse in Milwaukee hospitals who, in retirement, earned respect as a fearless and dedicated advocate for Milwaukee's parks and historic architecture. The proposed tagline for this plaque is, \"Historic People\" since she is one of Milwaukee's historically noteworthy people, rather than one of its many historic properties, which might be served by the tagline, \"Historic Properties.\" A supporting photo (of the proposed plaque as designed by TQ Sculpture, Inc.) can be mailed separately upon request.
