Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. - 4. On 10/07/20 at 8:15pm, officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Taco Bell, 6268 S. 27th St. Officers interviewed the caller who stated she placed an order through the drive thru, drove off, then realized she was missing part of her order. The caller stated when she returned the door was locked to gain entry so she had to wait in a long line to get the problem rectified. The caller further stated by the time she reached the drive thru window, she wanted a refund for all her food because it was now cold. Officers interviewed the manager who stated they lock the lobby early due to COVID. The manager stated the caller was extremely irate and yelling, however, refunded her for the portion of food she was missing. The caller left without further incident.
- 5. On 03/01/21 at 1:50am, officers were dispatched to Taco Bell, 6268 S. 27th St., for an Injured/Sick Person. Officers interviewed the caller who stated a subject was passed out at the drive thru window with the money for the food in hand. The caller stated MFD had been on scene and allowed the subject to walk home, since they lived around the corner. On officers arrival the vehicle had already been moved.
- 6. On 03/03/21 at 10:50am, officers were dispatched to Taco Bell, 6268 S. 27th St., for a Trouble with Subject. Officers interviewed the manager who stated he was having trouble with an employee over a disciplinary issue. The employee was asked to leave by the officers and complied.
- 7. On 03/04/21 at 9:08am, officers were dispatched to Taco Bell, 6268 S. 27th St., for a Trouble with Subject. Officers were advised by an employee that a physical fight took place between the manager and an employee who had previously been fired. Officers observed both subjects on the ground with visible scratches and torn clothing. The employee was advised to leave the premises and the manager was advised to contact Human Resources in the future with personnel matters.

8. On 10/24/21 at 5:05pm., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 6268 S. 27th St. Officers were advised by management; two employees were fired earlier in the day and were causing a disturbance. Upon police arrival the subjects were no longer on scene.

9. On 09/13/22 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 6268 S. 27th St., for a Child Enticement complaint. Officers spoke with the juvenile victim who stated that his boss asked him to have sex with him while they were working alone in the business. The victim stated that he refused and a few days after the initial proposal his boss asked to perform oral sex on him. During the investigation officers inspected text messages between both parties. Officers observed texts were the supervisor/boss provided alcohol to the victim and allowed him to smoke marijuana on the premise, while working. Separate police reports are filed regarding the full scope of the investigation.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by PO Jedidiah THOMPSON, assigned to District 6 late shift.

On 9/13/22 I investigated a complaint of a Child Enticement which had occurred at the Taco Bell focated at 6268 S 27th St. The Victim, a 16 year old male juvenile, reported that his boss, Andrew D SOLANO, had asked to have sex with him while they were working at the restaurant alone, and he refused. The victim stated that a few days after that SOLANO met with him at the store parking lot and offered him \$60 to let him perform oral sex on the victim.

During the course of my investigation, I took victim statements, a mirandized interview of SOLANO, and inspected text messages between them on both of their phones. I observed that both people admitted and texts confirmed that SOLANO provided alcohol to the victim, drank with the victim on the premises during working hours, and allowed the victim to smoke marijuana on premises while working.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/7/2023 at 9:00 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
