PORT MILWAUKEE, CITY OF MILWAUKEE/MILWAUKEE COUNTY, WI

AND

THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

This Amendment 3 to Harbor Assistance Program Grant Agreement No. 0495-22-04 dated the 22nd day of August 2022 is hereby amended and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2025, by Port Milwaukee (PORT) and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT).

WHEREAS, the PORT and WisDOT entered into a Grant Agreement dated August 16, 2022 (“Original Grant Agreement”) concerning a project to repair dockwall in the Inner Mooring Basin at Port Milwaukee in the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, as described in Original Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, PORT and WisDOT entered into a Grant Amendment 1 dated December 15th, 2023 (“Grant Amendment 1”) concerning a modification of time to complete the work identified in the Original Grant Agreement as amended; and

WHEREAS, PORT and WisDOT entered into a Grant Amendment 2 dated September 19th, 2025 (“Grant Amendment 2”) concerning a second modification of time to complete the work identified in the Original Grant Agreement as amended; and

WHEREAS, the PORT was awarded \$1,175,000 in Harbor Assistance Program Grant funds as described in the Original Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the PORT has incurred increased costs related to approximately flood damage of 80 feet of dockwall sustained during a catastrophic extreme rainfall event and 1,000-year flood in August 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby mutually agree to immediately increase the funding commitment from HAP by \$200,000 for emergency repairs of flood-damaged dockwall. The total amount of HAP funds allotted through project 0495-22-04 is \$1,375,000.
