I am a current resident of the Melody View neighborhood and it has been brought to my attention that a juvenile correction facility is being proposed nearby. With the governor stating this a "major step," I am shocked that the surrounding neighborhoods have been kept in the dark about this. However, this doesn't come as a complete surprise as our community lacks any representation. With our alderwoman removed from office, this appears to be a sly attempt to quickly relocate the facility with a quick vote on Friday. The previous location was opposed because the community DID NOT want this in their neighborhood. I suspect ours will have similar reservations about locating this facility near our homes.
