Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 021088

Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 021088 being a petition submitted by Slims, for a special privilege to place a storm enclosure on the north side of East Florida Street adjacent to the property at 338 South 1st Street.

The request is to place a storm enclosure on the sidewalk in the public right-of-way, at the north side of East Florida Street, approximately 75 feet east of South 1st Street. At the time of our field investigation, we found the structure already in place. The enclosure extends approximately 4 feet into the 15-foot wide sidewalk area, leaving approximately 11 feet of clear sidewalk for pedestrians. The structure is to act as a vestibule, since there is only one door in this building entry. The structure is "see-through".

We do not believe the storm enclosure will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution that, if adopted, would allow the storm enclosure to encroach into the public right-of-way.
