There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Good Morning Bob:

Last night when I was waiting for an eastbound bus on Wis. Ave. at the stop in front of Amalinda/The Box (315 E. Wisconsin) at 5 p.m., I was surprised to find a valet parking stand/podium on the sidewalk (close to the alley). The issue was not the stand, however, but the 5 orange traffic cones that the attendants had placed in the street, blocking a lane of traffic - 2 cones west of the alley and 3 east of the alley. This caused traffic congestion, horn-honking, unanticipated merging, and prevented buses from pulling up to the bus stop (my bus stopped out in the traffic lane). I don't believe there is even a loading zone there, but even if there is, it doesn't give the holder of the loading zone permit the right to put traffic cones in the street or to any kind of exclusive use of the zone.

By the way, it appeared that the valet parking service was serving The Box, because I saw a couple pull up to it, turn over their vehicle, and walk into The Box.

I hope you can get this issue rectified soon.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/5/2018 at 1:15 PM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

2. On 04/10/08 at 12:52 am, Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 927 N 27th Street. Officers spoke to Corre Blount who was bartending. Blount was found not to have a bartenders license and stated he was working under the direction of another bartender, Harold Jenkins, who was licensed. Officers spoke with Jenkins and found his license was expired. Blount received a citation for Class D License Required and a routine wanted check revealed Jenkins had an outstanding warrant. Jenkins was placed into custody. The licensee Gary Lieske was not scene at the time of the violation but appeared in the tavern while officers were investigating. Police advised Lieske of the violations and cited Lieske for Class B Licensee's Responsibility.

3. On 05/10/08 at 2:00 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 927 N 27th Street for a Reckless Use complaint. Officers spoke to Gary Lieske who stated he had video surveillance of a subject who had discharged a handgun at 913 N 27th Street sometime after closing. Lieske advised officers that there were no problems in the tavern and that he would provide a copy of the video when he was able to download it. A report was filed.

4. On 05/28/09 at 2:55 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting Sales of Alcohol To Underage Persons and had a police aide who is under the age of 21 enter 927 N 27th Street in attempts to purchase alcohol. The bartender Joan Cross served the aide two beers without asking for any ID. The licensee Gary Lieske was issued a citation for Sale of Alcohol To Underage Person.

 On 08/18/2013 Officers went to the business Gare-Bear's at 927 N 27th St and contacted the applicant regarding Secondhand Dealer Notification. The applicant was given a copy of MCO chapter 92 regarding Secondhand Dealers. He signed an acknowledgement.

- 6. On 03/26/2014 at 2:10am Officers responded to Gare-Bears at 927 N. 27th St for a Battery Complaint. The investigation revealed the caller, Brian PETERSON, went into the tavern after last call and got upset that he could not get served alcohol. The bartender, Coree BLOUNT, asked PETERSON to leave and was walking to the door when PETERSON struck him to the face in an unprovoked attack. A physical altercation ensued until BLOUNT and several patrons were able to get PETERSON out of the bar. The applicant was on scene and provided the video tape of the incident, which confirmed the statement of the bartender. Battery report #14-085-0015 was filed but BLOUNT did not wish to prosecute.
- 7. On 09/13/2015 Milwaukee police investigated a battery/cutting at 927 North 27th Street (Gare Bear's). Video from the business indicates the victim of this offense was involved in an argument inside the bar. The argument continued outside, where the victim attempted to punch his assailant and both parties appear to arm themselves with pieces of broken glass they pick up from the ground. The victim received lacerations on his torso which required 33 stitches to close. Milwaukee police incident report #152560020 filed.
- 8. On 10/27/2017 Milwaukee police responded to a sick/injured person at 927 North 27th Street (Gare Bear's Tavern). Investigation revealed a patron of the bar was almost falling out of his chair and his head would go from side to side and front to back. This behavior occurred after the patron returned from using the bathroom, prompting the caller to believe the patron was on drugs. The officer discovered the patrons head would go limp and wobble from side to side. When the officer asked the patron if he had taken any drugs and how much he had to drink, the patron would return a blank stare and his head would fall limply forward. The patron was conveyed by ambulance to Mt. Sinai hospital where it was discovered his blood alcohol concentration was .285. Milwaukee police incident report #163010123 filed.
- 9. On 12/15/2017 officers were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27th St. The officers received an update prior to arrival the call was a false alarm and there was no problem at the bar. They interviewed the maintenance man, Coree BLOUNT, who stated he did observe two subjects, who had been in the bar, arguing outside but no gun was observed. The officers did not locate the subjects.
- 10. On 01/22/2018 officers were dispatched to a shooting at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27th St. The officers found a subject lying on the sidewalk with a gunshot wound to the chest. The officers and MFD performed lifesaving measures but the subject was pronounced dead on the scene. The video surveillance showed the suspect exit the premises to smoke a cigarette. Outside the suspect bumped into the victim and after an argument he produced a handgun and shot the victim. The suspect then fled in his auto.
- 11. On 02/12/2018 at 9:02pm officers were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27th St. The bartender, Luis RIOS, stated he let a subject, Isadore JEFFERSON, sit in the bar to "warm up". He did not serve him since he already appeared intoxicated. Later a replacement bartender asked JEFFERSON to make a purchase or leave the premise. JEFFERSON then threatened to "pop" the bartender and stated he had a gun in his backpack. No gun was found on JEFFERSON.

- 12. On 02/25/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27th St. The victim reported she was assaulted by her ex-boyfriend who was no longer on scene. While the officers checked the area the applicant called 911 to report a subject causing a disturbance. The officers returned and spoke with the applicant who stated a different subject who had been kicked out had returned and was refusing to leave. The applicant gave the subject a pizza to leave.
- 13. On 04/23/2018 a meeting was held regarding Gare Bear's. The applicant stated he will take action in abating the problems that occurred by posting No Loitering signs, No Weapons signs, and all Persons subject to search signs. He also stated he will have security posted at the door on Fridays and Saturdays by 04/28/2018.
- 14. On 04/28/2018 an officer went to Gare Bear's, 927 N. 27TH St, to conduct a licensed premise check. The officer found security at the door wanding patrons as they can in the tavern. The bartender stated security was just hired and checks every patron for weapons.



This report was written by Police Officer Thomas DELANEY, District Three, Late Power Shift.

This report has been generated regarding a follow up request to check for compliance of a licensed premise.

On Saturday, April 28th, 2017, at approximately 11:15pm, P.O. Lori BORCHERT and I, squad 3457, checked the tavern at Gare Bear's bar (927 N 27th St). As I entered the bar, I observed a black male subject, identified as Marvin L. CERTION (b/m, 10-15-1967), standing inside the main entrance of the door holding a "wand" style metal detector. I then spoke to the bar tender, Eddie M. DANCY (b/m, 10-31-1958), who indicated to me the security guard was recently hired and began his employment approximately two days earlier. DANCY stated the security guard wands every patron who enters the establishment upon entry. As I spoke with DANCY, I did observe CERTION utilize his metal detector and screen incoming patrons at the door. I briefly spoke with CERTION who reiterated the standard practice of screening every patron.

BLOUNT stated there were never any firearms present, but he did observe two subjects who had previously been inside of the bar arguing outside of Gare Bear's. The subjects were no longer at the location, upon our arrival.

I spoke with the Licensee, Gary L LIESKE, after BLOUNT had contacted him, so I could notify LIESKE of our response and let him know that no criminal offense had occurred.

This report is written by P.O. Frank YINKO, District Three, Late Power Shift.

On Monday, January 22, 2018, Milwaukee Police Officers were dispatched to a Shooting at 927 N. 27th St. (Gare Bears).

Upon arrival, officers observed a victim lying on the sidewalk with a gunshot wound to the chest and another possible gunshot wound to the face. MPD officers, and later MFD personnel, conducted live-saving measures, but the victim was pronounced dead on scene.

Video surveillance showed the suspect exit the premise to smoke a cigarette while talking outside with two unknown citizens. The victim and suspect bumped into each other outside, and appeared to become engaged in a verbal altercation for approximately ten minutes. The suspect produced a handgun, and shot the victim. The victim appeared to reach for a weapon on his person after he was shot. The suspect fled the scene southbound in his vehicle. An MPD officer, who performed CPR on the victim, located a handgun in the victim's coat pocket.

An MPD officer located the suspect's vehicle, parked on the street, at approximately 601 N. 29th St. The vehicle was towed to the City Tow Lot for processing.

RIOS stated JEFFERSON said "touch me and I'm going to pop you" and "touch me, I'll beat your ass". RIOS stated JEFFERSON also said he had a gun in his backpack. On 02/16/2017 officers responded to a strong armed robbery call at State Beer Liquor, 2537
W. State St. The victim, who was a customer of the store, stated an unknown male pushed
him and took his money. The clerk observed the incident and was cooperative with the
officers. The video of the incident was recovered. Milwaukee Police Department IR# 17-0470137 filed.

- 3. On 08/25/2017 officers were dispatched to a strong armed robbery at 2537 W. State St. The clerk, Sukhwinder SINGH, stated a frequent customer came in and took three bottles of wine. The officers viewed the surveillance video and identified the subject who is known to them. He was stopped the next day and cited for this incident.
- 4. On 11/03/2017 officers were dispatched to State Beer and Liquor, 2537 W. State St for a trouble with subject. The applicant was on scene and stated a subject who had been banned was at the store refusing to leave. The subject was identified and cited.
- 5. On 11/05/2017 officers were dispatched to a fight inside State Beer and Liquor, 2537 W. State St. The officers spoke with the manager, Bhupinder SINGH, who stated a subject who had been banned was in the store causing a disturbance. He did not wish to press charges, he just wanted the subject to not return.
- 6. On 11/14/2017 officers were advised by the clerk at State Beer and Liquor of a theft that occurred on 11/13/2017. The clerk, Bhupinder SINGH, stated a subject took a bottle of liquor without paying for it. The officers viewed the video and identified the subject who was known to them. A report was filed and presented to the District Attorney's office.
- 7. On 11/26/2017 at 4:26am officers were dispatched to an entry to business complaint at 2537 W. State St. The investigation revealed an entry did occur and bottles of alcohol were taken. The applicant was on scene and cooperative. He did not know how to view the surveillance at the store monitors but showed the officer on his phone.
- 8. On 12/17/2017 at 4:19am officers were dispatched to an entry complaint at 2537 W. State St. The officer cleared the building but did not locate any suspects. The applicant arrived and showed the officer video surveillance on his phone. The video showed a subject entering through a side door and removing property. By renewing of the license, you are supporting these activities in our neighborhood. I have lived in the neighborhood for over 14 years and it's the same every year.

The area is already heavily populated with license in the Concorida and Avenue West Neighborhood.

This location and its issues has continued for years and we have endured this inconvenience for years and it is totally unacceptable to expect the residents to continue to do so. We must look out for the protection of our children from harm, with three schools located within a block or two blocks, the third with a few blocks of the liquor store. With Families with Children living in the neighborhood seeing this activity can affect a young person and their quality of life and resident's quality of life.

It effects an investor's decision as tow whether they want to invest their money into Concorida or Avenue West neighborhood.

The truth is thru Studies, that a neighborhood that has alcohol sales tend to have higher crime rates, lower property values and less pride in the neighborhood. State Street is heavily traveled street with

commuters to work and back home daily. This is what we get to show them as daily representation of our community and our neighborhood. The AADT (traffic count) daily is 7,600 West and East on State Street.

We need your help for change. The issues created by liquor sale at this premise create the problems in our neighborhood. I would urge the Committee to consider the impact this license has upon our neighborhood. The Health Impact to the neighborhood and Safety Issues.

I would urge the Licensing Authority to refuse the renew of this license. I also urge you to take some time and sit across the intersection and watch the activities thru out the day yourself. This premise threatens the health and safety of the neighborhood residence and business.

Liquor store activity; 2537 West State Street,

The store isn't open yet, but customers are already lined up in front of the store or parked on the street in vehicles waiting for 8:00 A.M. for the door to open. In the winter less but in the warm weather customer will make their purchases and leave or other wise hang outside the premises, socializing with other customers panhandling will happen for money to purchase liquor. Some of the customers will go around to 26th Street drink along the side of the liquor store or head down to the intersection of 26th and Kilbourn Ave, consume the alcohol thrown the purchases on the ground continue toward Penfield School.

We used to have Planners Boxes, Seating and a Community Garden on the City Vacant lot. It turned into an area for the liquor store customers to sit, drink, urine, and get out of control. The only way to get rid of these activities was to discontinue the Community Garden and to remove the bench and planter boxes. (see photo's)

Instead of plants we end up being a garbage disposal area of liquor containers, and liquor store customers to lounge. It was out of control.

If they didn't go down 26th Street, they headed down State Street to 25th Street. Along the way they drank and dispose their liquor containers. Would stop and socializing, usually a group in around ATT planter boxes, sit on the planter boxes, eat and drink and urine in the corner of the building. Then they would continue down to Kilbourn Ave take a left head East. If they would get tired, they would sit on steps, lay on the grass of yards, even pass out. They would go up the ally drinking hang out on the two City lots (, urine in the tree areas). They left their liquor containers behind, food container and the plastic bag.

Its known, I've been told this by a patron that people in vehicles buy the nip bottles. Because they feel they don't have open containers and as they drive they drink and thrown the empties out the car windows.

Otherwise they will park around the corner drink, play loud music and socialize with other customers.

Sometimes of the day its quite other times its busy and a large group outside of the liquor store.

We have a large amount of crime in the area around this liquor store location, it is usually assaults, and robbery, vandalism, other, burglary, shooting, vehicle break-ins as listed on the crime alerts in this area.

- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
