COOPERATION AGREEMENT Tax Incremental District No. 66 (Metcalfe Park Homes Project)

COOPERATION AGREEMENT

for

Tax Incremental District - Number 66 (Metcalfe Park Homes)

THIS COOPERATION AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is entered into
as of this day of, 2006 by and between the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, a
municipal corporation (the "City") and the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee, a
public body corporate and politic organized and existing under the laws of the State of
Wisconsin (the "Authority").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Authority, with the cooperation of the City has undertaken to develop and carry out the Metcalfe Park Homes Project which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin and is generally described on Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Authority adopted Resolution Number 66 (hereinafter the "Resolution") on October 19, 2006 creating the Metcalfe Park Homes Tax Incremental District in conjunction with the implementation of Metcalfe Park Homes Project; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution is attached hereto as Exhibit"B"; and

WHEREAS, the Metcalfe Park Homes Project is located within the boundaries of Tax Incremental District Number 66 (hereinafter "TID - 66) which is depicted on the map attached as Exhibit "C." The City intends to provide the Authority with the funds necessary to finance all

TID - 66 project costs, as set forth on the budget attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein as Exhibit "D" (the "Budget"); and

WHEREAS, the activities to be undertaken within TID - 66 are described in the Project Plan for Tax Incremental District - 66, City of Milwaukee (the "TID - 66 Project Plan") which is attached as Exhibit "E"; and

WHEREAS, All costs set forth on the Budget are to be expended within the area of the Metcalfe Park Homes Project and the boundaries of TID - 66; and

WHEREAS, The Authority also authorized execution of this Agreement by Resolution No. 9859 adopted October 19, 2006, and the City authorized execution of this Agreement by Resolution No. _____ adopted ______, 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, The parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Project Definition</u>. The Authority agrees to implement and to carry out the Metcalfe Park Homes Project as well as the TID 66 Project Plan contingent upon the Authority receiving adequate financing from the City. The City agrees to provide the Authority with the funds necessary to carry out the TID 66 Project Plan, said funds being provided in aid of the activities of the Authority relative to the Metcalfe Park Homes Project.
- 2. <u>Establishment of Fund Account.</u> The City will provide to the Authority, from Tax Incremental Bond Account No. _____ and/or from any other source as determined by the Common Council, including Contingent Fund, (hereinafter referred to as the "Fund") for costs specified in the Budget. Such funds as are approved by the Common Council to be made available to the Authority, either: a) upon the approval by the Public Debt Commission of the necessary borrowing after the adoption of an initial bond resolution by the Common Council; or b) from available TID funds. Funds are to be made available to the Authority upon requisition by

the Secretary of the Authority according to a procedure mutually agreed upon between the City Comptroller and the Secretary. The requisition funds, to the extent received by RACM, shall be placed in a separate bank account (the "Fund Account") by the Authority and shall not be commingled with other funds of the Authority.

- 3. Administration of the Fund Account. The City Comptroller shall review and approve the accounting and financial reporting systems necessary to administer the Fund Account.
- 4. <u>Use of Fund</u>. Funds granted by the City to the Authority shall be utilized for the purpose of implementing the Metcalfe Park Homes Project, as specified in the Budget, and to provide for the improvements and other activities specified in the TID 66 Project Plan.
- 5. <u>Verification by Comptroller</u>. The City Comptroller shall, from time to time as in the Comptroller's judgment is appropriate, review the receipts and expenditures of the Authority in connection with the Metcalfe Park Homes Project and TID 66 activities and the Comptroller shall make an accounting to the City. The Comptroller shall conduct an audit and report to the Common Council with respect to the results of such audit. Upon completion of the Metcalfe Park Homes Project and TID 66 activities, the Authority shall make a full accounting to the City of income received and amounts expended and shall return to the City all unused and unneeded funds.
- 6. <u>Construction of Improvements</u>. The Authority may construct or cause to be constructed within TID 66 such improvements as are provided for in the TID 66 Project Plan or as shall be determined by resolution of the Common Council amending the TID 66 Project Plan. The cost of said improvements shall be fully paid from the Fund.
 - 7. Supplemental Redevelopment Activity by City.

- a. The City in furtherance of the Metcalfe Park Homes Project will vacate, if will take any lawful actions as nay be deemed by the City and the Authority to be necessary or desirable in connection with the Metcalfe Park Homes Project and TID 66.
- b. The Department of City Development, Department of Neighborhood Services and other City Departments shall assign personnel to implement and complete the Metcalfe Park Homes Project and TID - 66 in accordance with the annual service contract between the City and the Authority.
- 8. <u>Interest Payments</u>. Any sums payable hereunder by either party to the other shall not bear any interest, but any interest earned on such sums shall be transferred to the City.
