**Regarding:** Your Class A Fermented Malt and Food Dealer Licenses Renewal Application for "RICHARD'S GROCERY" at 2438 W GREENFIELD Av. 

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

**Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.**

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

9. On 01/05/2018 officers were dispatched to 2400 W. Greenfield Av for a Strong Armed Robbery complaint. The caller, Gilberto VELAZQUEZ, is an employee at Richard's Foods, 2438 W. Greenfield Av, and stated he was at the rear of the business attempting to solicit a female subject for an act of prostitution. He stated she attempted to grab something from his pocket, so he punched her. The female she refused his request and pulled a knife when VELAZQUEZ began to argue with her. The other store employee stated VALAZQUEZ would no longer be allowed in the store.
10. On 02/12/2018 officers were dispatched to Richard's Food, 2438 W. Greenfield Av, to investigate a Strong Armed Robbery. The officer located the caller at 2400 W. Greenfield Av. The subject is known to police to use 911 to call in non-emergency calls. The officers spoke with the applicant who was at the business. He stated the subject attempted to buy a soda but did not have enough money and caused a disturbance when he was asked to leave. The subject admitted he called because of the way the clerk was talking to him. While on scene the officer observed numerous expired food items and a customer approached the clerk asking to purchase two loose cigarettes. The clerk grabbed an open pack of cigarettes, then stated they no longer sell loose cigarettes.
11. On 02/28/2018 officers, along with agents from the State of Wisconsin department of Revenue, conducted an inspection of Richard's Grocery, 2438 W. Greenfield Av, regarding complaints of selling single cigarettes and expired foods. No violations were found regarding tobacco products. Approximately 60 food products were found to be expired. The brother of the owner, Naser ASAD, stated the expired food products would be disposed of.

12. On 03/11/23, Milwaukee Police were assigned to work Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Initiative. At approximately 12:04p.m., the youth entered 2438 W. Greenfield and purchased a tobacco product from the clerk, who did not ask or check ID. The officer identified the employee based on the description and the employee admitted to the sale and apologized.

13. On 08/09/23 at 9:00a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 2438 W. Greenfield Av. Assisting in this assignment was an agent from Wisconsin Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco. Officers found the establishment to be open business, however, the sole employee on scene did not possess a Class D Operator License. The DOR Agent found the establishment did not have 2 years of invoices for alcohol and tobacco purchases, as well as items for sale were malted beverages and not fermented malt beverages. The officer also observed expired meat products.

14. On 03/06/25 at 3:46p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Officers were advised by the caller, an employee punched them once in the mouth after an altercation regarding the caller being banned from the store for stealing. The employee was arrested; however, further investigation revealed the caller was the primary physical aggressor.

15. On 05/12/25 at 12:00a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon, later determined to be a Stolen Auto, however, this had nothing to do with the business, just that it was parked near the closed business.
  
16. On 06/03/25 at 6:55p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired in the area of 25<sup>th</sup> and Greenfield, in which the caller stated they observed occupant(s) of a vehicle firing shots at another occupied vehicle. The caller's vehicle was struck and 16 casings were recovered. On 06/04/25, officers conducted follow up at 2438 W. Greenfield., in an attempt to view video surveillance of the incident. The employees initially denied being present during the incident as well as denied having a firearm on the premise, hindering the investigation. Further investigation revealed the employee's as well as Agent were on scene, appeared to have knowledge of the incident, did have a firearm and retrieved it, as well as attempted to disconnect/disable the camera system shortly after the incident occurred. Two employees were arrested for Obstructing and a warrant had to be drafted to obtain DVR Surveillance. No one from the business ever called the police.

On Thursday, March 6th, 2025, PO AL-ZALLOUM and I were dispatched to the address of 2438 W. Greenfield Ave Richards Food Market which is in the City and County of Milwaukee WI for a battery complaint.

On scene PO AL-ZALLOUM and I made contact with caller/ victim identified as Sergio A. MARTINEZ (w/m 05/02/2002) who stated on above listed day, date at approximately 3:40 PM he went to above listed location and was immediately stopped by employee identified as Anas SALEM (a/m 11/13/1987).

MARTINEZ stated SALEM stated he was not allowed into the store due to him stealing items the day prior and the incident was observed on video footage. MARTINEZ stated he asked to view the video footage and was denied. MARTINEZ stated SALEM approached him and got close to his face and began shouting. MARTINEZ stated as SALEM was shouting saliva got onto his face and he got upset and raised his fist and told him to chill. MARTINEZ stated SALEM then punched him once to the mouth causing his lip to split open.

MARTINEZ conveyed to Saint Francis Hospital.

SALEM was arrested on scene and conveyed to District Two for booking.

This report is summarized by me after reviewing Police Reports, Officers body camera and the Swann Surveillance system footage.

On Tuesday, 3rd of June 2025, *Milwaukee Police Officers* were dispatched to the area of *S 25th St and W Greenfield Ave* for a *Shots fired call*.

Squad 2221, PO. Christopher MCCRAY and PO Wynald WILLIAMSON, while saturating the area, we were flagged down in front of the residence of 1319 South 25th Street by the listed victim who identified himself as Luis A VILLALVA-BUENO (w/m 05-11-76). VILLALVA-BUENO stated at approximately 6:50PM, he parked his vehicle in front of the listed incident address. VILLALVA-BUENO parked on the west side of the street facing south bound. VILLALVA-BUENO stated once he parked, he observed a black vehicle already parked on the east side of the street facing north bound directly across from him.

VILLALVA-BUENO stated approximately thirty seconds later he observed a gray vehicle turn north bound from 25th and Greenfield. VILLALVA-BUENO observed the vehicle parked and observed a possible Hispanic male exit from the front passenger seat and immediately began to fire shoots towards the black vehicle. VILLALVA-BUENO stated that both vehicles proceeded to flee north bound. VILLALVA-BUENO stated that he exited and observed that his vehicle had been struck four times. VILLALVA-BUENO was unable to get a definite make and model of both vehicles. VILLALVA-BUENO was unable to get any demographics or clothing description of the shooter.

Officers recovered sixteen (16) spent, 9mm blazer casing recovered on the west side walk of 2436 west Greenfield. One bullet fragment was also recovered next to the listed victim's vehicle. All spent casings and fragment were recovered an inventoried

On Wednesday, June 4, 2025, MPD officers did follow up at Richards Food Mart, located at 2438 West Greenfield Avenue, located in the City and County of Milwaukee regarding A Shots Fired (case number C2506030165).

Upon arrival to the scene, PO Salah La-Zalloum spoke with to Sadam S. SALEM (W/M 12-05-82), Anas S. SALEM (W/M 11-13-1987) and Naser A ASAD (W/M 10-09-1969) all three individuals work at Richard's Food Mart.

PO Al-Zalloum spoke with Sadam who wanted to communicate in Arabic. When Sadam was asked about surveillance cameras specifically the outside ones Sadam that they had a new camera system installed and might have some video footage lost. and that the outside cameras has been off line for approximately one week.

Sadam stated that he owns the whole building but his uncle Naser A ASAD (W/M, 10/09/1969) owns the business.

PO Al-Zalloum then spoke with Naser A ASAD. PO Al-Zalloum asked if they kept any weapons or firearms in the store. ASAD repeatedly stated that they do not. PO Al-Zalloum pointed out that prior License Premises reports Sadam told officers that there was a firearm stored at the store for protection. ASAD asked Sadam if there were any weapons, Sadam mentioned that if there are any weapons it will be his fathers. After asking several times the location of the gun PO Al-Zalloum was directed to the cabinet near the north side of the register where PO Al-Zalloum located a black revolver and the rear shelf, along with a box of ammunition.

Both Sadam and Anas stated that they were not on the scene during the time of the incident. PO Al-Zalloum reviewed camera footage which showed both subjects inside of the store, and exiting and reentering during the time of the incident. While continuing to investigation, Sadam shortly admitted to hiding a DVR which possibly showed the Shots Fired Incident. The DVR was located in the basement of the store. It was determined that both Sadam and Anas knowingly providing false information with the intent to mislead officers from investing the incident. Both were arrested for obstructing and conveyed to Milwaukee Police District Two for booking and processing.

Inquiry of the CAD system there was only one 911 caller, which was not anyone who is associate with the Richards Food Mart.

Sadan, Anas or Nader failed to call police about this incident.

## Two Swann DVR's were seized and placed on MPD Inventory.

On August 6th, 2025, I, PO Boyd drafted a warrant for Swann DVR surveillance system which was reviewed by ADA Nathan McClure and granted by Milwaukee County Circuit court Commissioner Susan Roth.

On September 8th, 2025, I, PO Boyd reviewed the partial footage of the Swann DVR surveillance system.

### Item 18:

File "ch8\_2025-06-03\_180000\_2025-06-03\_185925\_id1-1817":

I observed Channel 8 dated 06/03/2025 started time 18:00:00.

View of channel 8 is inside of the store front/register office which was enclosed by Plexiglas.

I observed, Sadam, Anas, **Osyed SALEM (W/M, 12/23/2025)** and Nader A ASAD (W/M, 10/09/1969) were present at the store day of the incident (6/3/25). (Sadam, Anas, Osyed are brothers, and all work at Richard's Food Mart with Nader)

At 18:27:03 Anas SALEM behind the register in the front office of the store. Then I observed **Osyed S. SALEM** entered the front office of the store in the hurry. Anas points to the area that is located right under the camera. Osyed bends over and retrieves a **revolver** from one of the shelves underneath the camera. Osyed then quickly exits the office. Anas follows Osyed. Anas returns to the office approximately 18:27:51.

At same time I'm able to observe Sadam's feet by the front office doors.

At approximately 18:47:32 Anas walks out from the front office and Sadan takes over Anas's position at the register.
