File # 020320 is an ordinance relating to ambulance conveyance rates.

## Background

- 1. Section 75-15-14-a of the Milwaukee Code requires the commissioner of health to review and report annually to the common council ambulance conveyance rates established under Section 75-15-14 par. c and recommend, if appropriate, an adjustment in the conveyance rate.
- 2. This ordinance increases the amount charged for both Basic Life Support and Basic Life Support-Emergency ambulance conveyances for the two categories of patients established by the code, *residents* of the City of Milwaukee and *non-residents*.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The increases in ambulance conveyance rates established by this ordinance are as follows:
  - For residents, from \$325 to \$336.
  - For non-residents, from \$375 to \$388.
  - 2. The new rates reflect a 3.5% increase, consistent with the 2000-2001 Milwaukee consumer price index for medical care.
- 3. The mileage rate, \$8.76/mile, will remain the same.

## Fiscal Impact

Passage of this ordinance has a minimal fiscal impact. Police prisoners needing to be transported by private ambulance will be charged 60% of the established rate. The Milwaukee Police Department will be charged for this conveyance in the event that the prisoner is unable to pay.
