I have reviewed the fiscal note in the above file, which reports the impact of the wage agreement prepared by the Labor Negotiator for the Fire Equipment Dispatchers, Local 494. The total incremental costs as developed by my staff for the 2003 and 2004-2006 agreements by category are:
