1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The objective of the FIM Grant is to ensure continued support for agencies sponsoring outstation sites for the purposes of enrolling and maintaining eligibility for public entitlements such as Medicaid (T19), BadgerCare, Food Stamps, and Child Care.

The objective for the Medical Assistance Outreach Program within the Health Department is to identify low income families raising young children lacking important services such as health insurance and evaluate eligibility, refer, or troubleshoot their involvement in programs such as WIC, heat assistance, childcare assistance or other services.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This program relates to the City-wide strategic goal of improving the overall health of children. Funding under this grant will provide the department with additional resources to accomplish stated City and departmental goals.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The grant funds will be used to support the positions funded under the Medical Assistance Outreach program in an attempt to support the enrollment of children and families into entitlement programs and for the continue maintenance of such entitlements. Increasing the number of individuals or families on such entitlement programs assists the Milwaukee Health Department in improving and measuring the department's impact on the economic, environmental, human and social capitol of the target area. The program will assist individuals and families to obtain other Health Department services.

The FIM Grant through Community Advocates proposes a program that will permit the City of Milwaukee-Health Department to cover come of their costs through accessing Income Maintenance Funds.
