Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 110944

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 110944, being a resolution to grant a special privilege to Journey House Incorporated to construct and maintain a neighborhood gateway marker in the public right-of-way adjacent to the premises at 1344 South Layton Boulevard.

Journey House Incorporated obtained a grant to construct gateway markers at the “corners” of the Clark Square Neighborhood. Due to conflict with various underground utilities, only one of the gateway markers will be in the public right-of-way. This marker is located in the east, 15-foot wide sidewalk area of South Layton Boulevard adjacent to the property at 1344 South Layton Boulevard. The steel marker with concrete base occupies an area that is 2 feet long and 2 feet 8 inches wide and has a total height of 6 feet 8 inches.

We are not aware that the presence of said neighborhood gateway marker will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will formally allow said neighborhood gateway marker to occupy the public right-of-way.
