Allocation Purpose:

Grant funds would be used by the Milwaukee Police Department's Anti-Heroin Task Force for overtime expenses associated with investigations focused on the illicit trafficking of heroin/opiates.

Program Goals:

The goal of this grant is to fund personnel for investigations which are focused on the illicit trafficking of opiates, heroin, or both. This will assist in furthering the investigations of drug traffickers in order to reduce the prevalence and demand for illegal narcotics in the City of Milwaukee.

Programmatic Summary:

Through the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Anti-Heroin Task Force Program Grant, the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI) will, reimburse for overtime expenses associated with the development and investigation of narcotics cases that target the illicit trafficking of heroin/opiates.

The money is designated only for reimbursement of overtime expenses related to these kinds of narcotics investigations, and must be tracked separately from any existing federal or state grant funded overtime or additional local agency funding.
