To reduce driver confusion and increase safety at the intersection of West Forest Home Avenue and West Lincoln Avenue, the removal of the right turn only lane on South Muskego Avenue southbound at West Forest Home Avenue is recommended. The removal of the lane is recommended because the recent repaving of West Forest Home Avenue from West Lincoln Avenue to South 27th Street has reduced westbound traffic on West Forest Home Avenue to one lane that is fed by two lanes on South Muskego Avenue southbound, leading to confusion and erratic lane use on West Forest Home Avenue through the intersection of West Lincoln Avenue.
