This is to notify you that on Tuesday, February 13, 2024, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew with a 30 (thirty) day suspension the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, licensee, friend and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety and welfare of the public for the shooting, illegal drug activity and materials harmful to minors; for the premises located at 1631 W Grant St. ("Primos Place").

On February 15, 2024, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 30 (thirty) day suspension of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, licensee, friend and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety and welfare of the public for the shooting, illegal drug activity and materials harmful to minors. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, February 27, 2024 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by a counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted renewal with a 30 (thirty) day suspension of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, licensee, friend and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety and welfare of the public for the shooting, illegal drug activity and materials harmful to minors. The suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on March 8, 2024 until 11:59 p.m. on April 6, 2024.
