There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

- 2. On 12/05/2015 officers conducted a licensed premise check at The Point, 906 S. Barclay St. The applicant was on scene and explained they are open for special events only. No violations were observed.
- 3. On 05/14/2016 officers went to The Point, 906 S Barclay St, for a licensed premises check regarding a complaint of them having an outside Sangria bar and dancing. The officers spoke with the applicant and explained why they were there. A check of the PEP license showed there were two licenses (one for inside and one for the outside patio) which allowed dancing patrons. There were no violations observed.

- 4. On 02/17/2017 officers responded to 906 S Barclay St to investigate a pedestrian struck by a vehicle. The investigation revealed a security guard was attempting to speak to the driver of a vehicle, when the vehicle suddenly took off causing the guard to fall to the ground. The security guard was not injured.
- 5. On 03/17/2017 at 11:05pm officers responded to trouble with subject complaint at S. Barclay and W. National Av. The officer found a large group of juveniles that had left an underage event at The Point, 906 S Barclay St, which ended at 10:00pm. The juveniles were running in and out of traffic, yelling profanity at the police and participating in small fights. Four subjects were detained and cited.

6. On 03/31/2017 officers were monitoring the area of The Point, 906 S Barclay St, due to an underaged event. At approximately 10:45pm the event let out. About 100-150 juveniles began running in and out of traffic, were throwing rocks at moving vehicle, and were fighting. They then went to a nearby gas station causing the business to lock its doors. The juveniles were cruising in the area creating traffic congestion. A total of 17 officers responded to restore order. The officers found that the applicant had hired a promoter for the event and had not obtained a license for this event and the ones held on 02/17/2017 and 03/17/2017.

- 7. On 04/10/2017 a meeting was held with the applicant regarding the recent underaged event held at The Point, 906 S Barclay St. At the meeting was Travis CHAMBERS of Fresh Productions, who is the promoter of the event. He stated the hours of the future events would change from 7:00pm-11:00pm to 4:00pm-8:00pm. He has roughly 30 staff who "wand" attendees and he will have them conduct "pat downs". He will have staff track attendance to remain under the maximum capacity of 385. He is requesting to increase off-duty officers from 4 to 8 and will increase security to cover S. 1st St. Citations were issued to the applicant for the events held on 03/17/2017 and 03/31/2017.
- 8. On 04/16/2017 at 7:50pm officers were assigned to monitor the juvenile event at The Point, 906 S Barclay St. The officers secured from the event at 11:15pm without incident.
- 9. On 04/20/2017 officers received a complaint of naked women dancing at The Point, 906 S Barclay St. on 04/15/2017. The officers interviewed the applicant who stated there was a private event on 04/15/2017. He stated a couple of women stripped down to bikini top and bottoms. He stated he is aware full nudity is not allowed. The officers asked to view the video surveillance for that night and he stated he does not know how to operate the system. He stated he would contact the building owner and advise when the footage was available.

10. On 05/12/2017 the applicant met with representatives from the Milwaukee police department, the city attorney's office and Alderman Jose Perez at Milwaukee police district #2 regarding the incident outlined in #9 above. During this meeting, the applicant explained that he observed things during the event that he knew were incorrect but he took no action to correct them because he was scared. Additionally, the applicant denied that there was a collusive agreement between himself Robert Smith and Patsy James. It was suggested that he not use promoters, attend another PIVOT training, and that he provide an events list to the district. The applicant agreed to replace or fix the camera system, attend another PIVOT training, only use the establishment for special events and provide a list of events for the district.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Community Prosecution Unit (CPU).

On April 20, 2017, the District 2 CPU received an anonymous complaint from the Office of Alderman Jose Perez regarding The Point, located at 906 S. Barclay St. The complaint alleged there were naked women dancing at the location on April 15, 2017. Additionally, on May 6, 2017, while doing traffic control, Sergeant Christopher MARTIN was advised there were strippers inside the licensed establishment. Sergeant MARTIN also obtained videos from a confidential source that showed woman dancing and money being thrown at them.

The licensee, Claiborne GREEN, was contacted by phone and agreed to meet at the District 2 Police Station on May 12, 2017, at 12:00 p.m. In attendance were: Captain Heather WURTH, Sergeant Christopher MARTIN, Sergeant Chad RADEN, P.O. Kevin VODICKA, Assistant City Attorney (ACA) Heather HOUGH, Alderman Jose PEREZ, and I. During the meeting GREEN stated he did observe one woman's top slip during the event. Captain WURTH made an additional request or the video so it could be reviewed. (2 email requests had been made prior to the meeting) GREEN advised that the password was not working so the footage had not been recovered. GREEN eventually explained that there were things that he observed during the event that he knew were incorrect but that he did not stop them from happening because he "was scared shitless." GREEN explained that he thought if he turned off the music and turned on the lights things would get worse. Alderman PEREZ did advise GREEN that he believed he was attempting to operate as a night club instead of a special events venue which is what his plan of operation stated he would be operating. ACA HOUGH also explained that another concern that the city had was that there is a collusive agreement in place. She explained that there was a belief the the building owner, Robert SMITH and his mother, Patsy JAMES, who had been granted a Manager's License for The Point, were running the business. GREEN denied that they were operating the establishment, he did state that Patsy was the manager and that SMITH just maintains the building and any construction projects associated to the location.

It was suggested to GREEN to not use promoters for his events but that if he did to make sure he hired all the security for the events and to screen them. Additional suggestions included that he attend another PIVOT Training, that he provide an updated events' list to the district, and that he get his cameras working again.

GREEN agreed to replace/ fix the camera system. It should be noted that a copy of the 105-91 city ordinance was provided so he was aware what the city standards are. GREEN stated he would attempt to get the old system fixed within two weeks or install a new one. He stated he would attend an additional PIVOT Training, that he would return to his original plan of operation and only use the establishment for special events (weddings, corporate events, fundraisers, and talent shows), and provide a list of events for the district.

This report is written by Police Officer Taylor D. BAAS, assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift, Squad 2460 with Police Officer Eulia KAZACHENKO. On Friday, March 17th, 2017, at approximately 11:05PM, I was dispatched to the area of S. Barclay St and E. National Av., located in the City and County of Milwaukee, regarding trouble with subjects complaint. Upon arrival, I was informed that The Point (906 S. Barclay St.) had an event for underage children involving a dance party. The event ended at 10:00PM. Following the end of the event, a large group of participants did not wait for their parents to pick them up and roamed the area. Many of the subjects were not 17 and were disobeying multiple ordinances. I observed kids running in and out of traffic causing traffic to be disrupted. Kids on scene were given multiple warnings to return to The Point to wait for their rides. Most subjects refused and yelled profanity at the police and participated in small fights with other children. Many of the subjects were very unruly and disobeyed lawful commands from Officers in full uniform. While on scene, four subjects were detained and cited regarding. The subjects are listed on the other page. It must be noted that this is an on going issue with The Point having this event with underage children.

This report was submitted by P.O. Eulia KAZACHENKO who is assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift.

On Friday, March 31, 2017, P.O. SPITZER and I were assigned to a squad 2464 at approximately 10:30PM we were patrolling the area of The Point Night Club at 906 S. Barclay St., which is in the City and County of Milwaukee. CAD # 170903216.

On scene were Squad 3113 and Squad 3163 on a special assignment. CAD # 170902866.

The Point was hosting an underage party with approximately 200 people. Approximately 10:45PM the event let out, majority of who did not had a ride home. Approximately 100-150 juveniles started to run in and out of traffic creating traffic hazard, some were throwing rocks at moving vehicles, some were starting to fight between each other. A large group ran to a nearby gas station that is located at 1009 S. 1st St. creating a disturbance inside, which caused the business to lock doors. The juveniles who had vehicles were cruising in the area hanging out the vehicles and creating more traffic congestions.

I requested additional Squads to the area. It took total of ten (10) squads of seventeen (17) officers and supervisors. MPD officers spent approximately 31 hours total to get the area under control. At 11:13PM a call came in for Trouble with Juveniles (CAD # 170903415) in the area of S. 1st St. and W. National Ave. approximately 20 juveniles causing disturbance.

At 12:16AM a call came in for Curfew (CAD #: 170910044) in the area of 701 W. 1st St. Three (3) juveniles who attended The Point Club underage party requested a ride home from the police because they were stranded on the south side of Milwaukee. MPD Squad 2340 was sent; it took approximately an hour and a half of his shift to drive out of there assigned district to drop the juvenile's home.

When I spoke with the Point manager Patsy SMITH-JAMES (W/F, 8/30/42), who stated that they were unaware that they needed obtain a permit for this event.

During the investigation officers discovered that licensee, Claibome M. GREEN (W/M, 11/12/63), hired a promoter to host an underage event, which was done without a permit. This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Monday, April 10, 2017, at 1:00 PM, Captain Heather WURTH, SGT. Marissa GUTMANN-GNADNT, SGT Chad RADEN, P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, Alderman Jose PEREZ, A.C.A. Heather HOUGH, and I met with the licensee of The Point, Claiborne GREEN, and the Market Manager/Promoter for Fresh Empire, Travis CHAMBERS, regarding the recent underage events that have occurred at the premises. After an introduction copies of MCO 90-19 to MCO 90-19.5 were distributed and explained. The ordinances outline the procedure for proper notification of events where underage persons will be present at a licensed premises during hours when alcohol is normally sold and outline penalties for the presence of underage persons present at a licensed premises. A brief summary of the underage events and the police response were presented and parties voiced concerned over future underage events, the lack of proper notification, and the possible effects to the license.

CHAMBERS stated that Fresh Productions serves and engages at-risk youths by hosting a mix of events that include but are not limited to; birthday parties, social events, and music performances that are all aimed at increasing tobacco awareness. CHAMBERS has hosted at least twelve (12) events in the City of Milwaukee since Memorial Day 2016, with the last three events occurring at The Point and two future events scheduled to occur at the location. CHAMBER stated that attendance at the events started at around eighty (80) persons and is four hundred (400) to four hundred and fifty (450). CHAMBERS stated that a nationwide attendance cap has now been set at five hundred (500) to five hundred and fifty (550) for the events. CHAMBERS stated that the current hours of the events are from 7:00 PM - 11:00 PM but would shift to 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM beginning in May. CHAMBERS stated that of the roughly 30 staff at an event there are unarmed security that "wand" attendees and will begin to conduct "pat downs" and track attendance with a hand counter in order not to exceed the maximum occupancy of 385 persons. CHAMBERS stated that as of the next event attendees will be required to show a form of identification to enter. CHAMBERS also stated that he had requested an increase in paid off-duty police presence from four (4) officers to eight (8) officers and that he had planned to increase the area security covers to include portions of S 1st St where problems had occurred at previous events. GREEN expressed his concerns about the past and scheduled events and Captain WURTH and A.C.A. HOUGH explained that it was the position or role of the Milwaukee Police Department to block future underage events. A.C.A. HOUGH explained the penalties for not making the proper notification to the department should additional underage events be held at the premises.

I served GREEN with two citations, for the events that occurred on 03/17/17 and 03/31/17, and explained the normal deposit for these citations is normally much larger than the \$321.00 because the deposit could include an additional \$200.00 per each additional underage person at the premises.

On 04/20/2017, the District 2 CPU received an anonymous complaint from the Office of Alderman Jose Perez regarding The Point, located at 906 S. Barclay St. The complaint alleged there were naked women dancing at the location on April 15, 2017.

On 04/21/2017, Squad 2268 (P.O. Erin JACKSON and I) contacted the licensee, Claiborne M. GREEN, who stated he would meet officers at the license establishment. At approximately 3:01 p.m., officers arrived at the location. GREEN stated that there was a private party at the location on April 15th. He stated there was no full nudity but that a couple of women who attended the event stripped down to bikini tops and bottoms. GREEN stated he was aware that full nudity was not allowed. I provided GREEN with a copy of MCO 108-22-Costume Regulations. I also requested to view video surveillance footage of the event but GREEN stated he did not know how to view the cameras. GREEN did call "Patsy," the building owner, to advise her that the police wanted to view the footage. GREEN was to call me when the footage was available to view. As of the date of this report CPU has not been contacted to view the video.

Clai,

During routine patrols last night in the Walker's Point area, squads observed a great deal of traffic congestion, reckless driving and loud music from vehicles stemming from the event held at The Point and security guards attempting to abate the issues. Squads conducted a traffic stop of a reckless vehicle from the area and during an interview of the driver, he indicated he was coming from your establishment during which there were "strippers" at the location and that they were "stripping" on the floor with an abundance of money being thrown at them for this activity. The delay in the squads entry into The Point was their attention being paid to the disorder on the streets that was taking place and attempts to clear that and to prevent any potential acts of violence.

When officers were able to enter and during the check of the interior, officers were told that by Patsy that she was unable to access the video system as they wanted to refute the claims of the aforementioned individual and she claimed did not know how to operate the system.

Based on the pictures and videos recovered below, as well as the vehicular activity outside of The Point, you can understand our concern about the events. As you are aware, we had reports of similar activity from an event held in April and our CPU officers reached out to you to view the video, again to ascertain the credibility of the claims.

Events held at your establishment, or any establishment, with little to no trouble do not frequently draw police attention and we certainly cannot be at all licensed premises at all times when events are held to see the "good" things that are being done. I welcome the list of future events being held and we will make efforts to visit on occasion.

I would encourage you to view the attached video and the attached pictures. While I appreciate the instructions given to the party host, it appears as though your instructions regarding this event were not followed. I'm curious to know what, if any, actions were taken by your security staff or licensees to address that activity, which I believe is in direct conflict with your instructions.

We fully support all responsible businesses in the District and make all attempts to be cooperative with those establishments to ensure they are safe and enjoyable to all the visitors. We want to maintain a relationship and do so without bias... for the success of the business owners and the continued development of the District.

We will likely arrange another meeting and I will have my CPU team make contact with you to advise you.


