Dear Council Members:

The 2005 Capital Improvement Program includes the improvement of South 6th Street from West Ohio Avenue to West Hayes Avenue under the Surface Transportation Program. The Federal Program provides cost participation for the improvement of traffic control devices in conjunction with the highway paving.

Eighty percent of the total cost will be funded by the Wiscons in Department of Transportation (WISDOT). The local share, \$5,703.61, will be provided through the Division's existing Capital Improvement Program.

We have, therefore, prepared the attached resolution, which authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an AUP contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install and/or modify traffic control facilities in conjunction with the improvement of South 6th Street from West Ohio Avenue to West Hayes Avenue in the 14th Aldermanic District.
