## **CC FILE #070231**

(Item #9 on July 24, 2007, Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development Committee agenda)

A substitute ordinance relating to board of zoning appeals and city plan commission consideration of applications for approval of various zoning-related matters.

I move for consideration of Proposed Substitute A in lieu of Substitute 1 for File 070231.

Proposed Substitute A differs from Substitute 1 in the following ways:

- a. Rather than stating that BOZA or the CPC shall not consider a request for a zoning-related matter unless the applicant submits an affidavit, it simply requires each applicant for a zoning approval to submit an affidavit.
- b. It eliminates the criteria relating to foreclosed property and to the applicant being convicted of a felony. But it adds a requirement that the applicant shall state whether he or she has been billed for the cost of police services under the chronic nuisance premises ordinance.
- c. It provides that the applicant shall swear to whether the applicant meets any of the criteria and all appeals have been concluded or the time to appeal has expired.
- d. If the applicant is a corporation, partnership, limited liability company or nonstock corporation, it requires that the affidavit be submitted by <u>one</u> duly authorized officer, director, partner, member or manager, rather than by <u>each</u> officer, director, partner, member or manager.

Also, in an opinion dated June 26, 2007, the City Attorney indicated that Proposed Substitute A is legal and enforceable.

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
