Curbing/planter will be on either side of the front service walk only. Height of curbing cannot be increased and must not be extended without prior approval from the Historic Preservation Commission.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
