Dear Alderman Witkowiak,

I wish to bring to your attention the following information revealed by the police investigation into the Hotel/Motel license renewal application filed by Milwaukee Parkway LLC, for the Parkay Hotel, 1574 W. National Avenue. Since the current license took affect on July 1, 2004, the following has occurred:

Between July 7, 2004 and February 15, 2005, twenty nine (29) individuals were issued municipal citations on twenty two (22) different dates for offenses of loitering (19), public drinking (6), disorderly conduct (5), assault and battery (2), trespassing (1), resisting/obstructing an officer (1), and hindering the issuance of a citation (1). All these citations resulted in a finding of guilty.

Between July 5, 2004 and April 18, 2005, there have been eighty nine (89) calls for service to the location of 1570 W. National Avenue as follows: trouble with a subject (33), battery (15), subject with a weapon (7), threat (2), indecent exposure (1), strong-arm robbery (1), theft (3), injured/sick person (6), 911 abuse (5), fight (4), drug dealing (1), indecent exposure (1) and miscellaneous calls for police service (15).

The Vice Control Division reports that on January 26, 2005, the manager of the Parkay Hotel called and reported "constant drug dealing in room thirty two (32)".

On September 29, 2004, the Commanding Officer of the Second District, Captain Andra Williams, notified Dean Stanley of Milwaukee Parkway LLC Hotel that the property at 1570 W. National Avenue was in danger of becoming a chronic nuisance based upon sixty one (61) nuisance related calls for police service to the property between January 25th and July 8th, 2004, and three calls for police service between September 2nd and September 27, 2004. Since October 8, 2004, there have been over seventy calls for police service to the location. This after

Mr. Stanley responded in writing to Captain Williams' letter that he would address the problems occurring in conjunction with the premises.

Police department records indicate that the problems that have occurred in conjunction with the operation of the Parkay Hotel have persisted over the years, and it is apparent that Milwaukee Parkway LLC has not demonstrated that it is properly addressing these problems as indicated above. Therefore, the Milwaukee Police Department objects to the renewal of the Hotel/Motel License for Milwaukee Parkway LLC.

### To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to Milwaukee City Ordinance 80-10 I am informing you that Milwaukee police officers have responded to a property you own at 1570 W. National Ave, on at least three occasions within a thirty-day period. The responses to your property (listed below) were for violations that are defined in Milwaukee City Ordinance 80-10 as a "Nuisance Activity".

In the period between January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2004 and July 8<sup>th</sup> 2004, Police Officers responded to calls for service at 1570 W. National Ave. on 94 separate occasions, 61 of which were nuisance related.

- 1) On Monday, September 27, 2004, at 1:35PM, an Officer observed three male subjects loitering at the building entrance at 1570 W. National Ave. Two were cited for loitering, one was cited for public drinking
- 2) On Saturday, September 25, 2004, at 12:39PM an officer observed a male subject loitering at the entrance to the building at 1570 W. National Ave. and issued a citation.
- 3) On Thursday, September 2, 2004, at 1:28AM, two Officers responded to a disturbance/trouble complaint in the common hallway at 1570 W. National Ave. where an argument in the hallway between two females was causing a disturbance

This letter is notice that, pursuant to section 80-10 (3) of the Milwaukee City Ordinances, your property is in danger of becoming a chronic nuisance. As the owner of the property at 1570 W. National Ave, you are subject to a special charge for any future enforcement costs for any of the listed violations in Milwaukee City Ordinance 80-10 that occur at your property. To avoid any special charges, you are directed to, within ten days of receipt of this letter, respond to my office with a written course of action that will abate the nuisance activities occurring at the property you own. I shall evaluate your proposed course of action to determine if it is a reasonable attempt at

abating the nuisance activity that is taking place at your property. If you wish to appeal this finding, please contact my office within ten days of receipt of this letter to schedule a meeting.

Please be aware that if you fail to respond to this written request and a subsequent violation, as listed in Milwaukee City Ordinance 80-10, occurs after 13 days of issuance of this notice that requires an enforcement effort, you will be subject to placement of a special charge as a lien on your property by the Commissioner of Neighborhood Services for the cost of such enforcement.

Dear Lt. Rodriguez,

Pursuant to our conversation on October 7, 2004 at 11:45.

As I understand of the city ordinance 80-10 I am making effort to rectify the issues at 1570 W. National Ave. I have only purchased this property approximating 1 ½ years ago and s you could imagine found some issues not disclosed by the previous owner. To rectify the issues at said address I have gone and installed a 24 hour a day video/online monitory system that can be accessed through the internet and is recorded on a hard drive. Access could be made available to you if you are interested. I have also informed the full time manager to evict any person suspected of crime or has a record of trouble. I hired a security person for 4-5 days a week (nights) to stop the night traffic in and out of the property. As discussed in our conversation, the front door opens on to National Ave. and public area. I cannot force people from loitering. We have "no loitering" signs posted inside and outside the property and have asked loiterers to leave. Furthermore, I have been working with Jeff Altenburg of the District Attorney's office and the vice control abatement officers providing them with resident lists weekly, working to provide secure areas, fencing, abandoned auto abatement clean up and we are trying to get a neighborhood security team in place.

I was unaware of the excess of calls regarding the property until I met with Mr. Altenburg in June. Since this time, the above plans have been implemented and the calls have dropped significantly. 7-9 calls have been documented, although some do not contain to 1570 W. National Ave.

To respond to the incident of September 25, 2004. All of the people involved were asked to leave by security, and refused. This also occurred on September 27, 2004. On September 2, 2004, both people were asked to leave the premises. I have been in contact with Mr. Altenburg regarding the letter on September 29, 2004 and he volunteered that if you need any further information regarding steps taken, please feel free to contact him at his office.


