Dear Ms. Clark:


This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$686.00, relating to the alleged damage sustained to your vehicle on February 13, 2004 when it was towed from the alley behind 3235 North 45th Street.

Our investigation reveals that your 1976 Pontiac was towed on February 13, 2004 for Illegal parking and Unpaid Citations. The tow lot records and intake video all indicate the vehicle had significant overall damage upon arrival at the tow lot. The PT-27 form that was completed prior to the tow note the vehicle was snowbound and abandoned. Since it appears the damage to your vehicle was pre-existing, the City cannot accept liability. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
