911 INCIDENT/RESPONSE SUMMARY

- 844 responses eliminated. (this is the sum of the 6 month post reductions)
- 1504 responses eliminated. (this is the sum of the 1 year post reductions)

COST SAVINGS SUMMARY

- Apparatus expenditures saved. (based on \$250.56 per apparatus costs projection)
 - o 6 month pre and post = \$211,472.64.
 - o 1 year pre and post= \$376,842.24
- Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) savings. (based on an average payment of \$310.00 per patient response)
 - o 6 month pre and post=\$261,640.00
 - o 1 year pre and post =\$466,240.00
