Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffit, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



I arrived on scene at approximately 1058AM and spoke to Loss Prevention ALLEN Teresa M B/F 03/12/1990. ALLEN informed me at approximately 1007AM, suspect, later identified as GREEN Tamara K B/F 04/30/1965, had passed the last point of sale and attempted to leave the store with two carts full of merchandise.

GREEN was apprehended by security and they recovered the the stolen items before she was able to leave the front entrance. ALLEN took GREEN into the lost prevention office where she was asked for her information. GREEN was argumentative with staff and pointed her finger in ALLEN's face. GREEN provided her full legal name, date of birth and address on a hand written note which was provided to ALLEN.

ALLEN provided me with receipt of the merchandise that was taken. The receipt indicted that these items were various items of clothing as well as food items. A total of 112 items were taken which had a total of \$1251.75. MIKULSKY reviewed camera footage provided by ALLEN. The camera footage showed GREEN passed the last point of sale with two carts of merchandise and attempted to leave the store. The camera footage was recorded on P.O. MIKULSKY's body worn camera.

We were shown a screen shot of the suspect's face and we compared it previous booking photos of GREEN. We were able to positively identify GREEN from the two photos. ALLEN was unable to give us a copy of the receipt due to her needing it for her records.

We found GREEN's last known address on file which was 2418 N. 8th St. We drove to her address however we were unable to locate her.

Walmart was cooperative with the investigation. The business had approximately 5 loss prevention officers on scene. They were unarmed. The loss prevention officers recovered the stolen property and received the subjects information. During my investigation for theft complaint I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

JOHNSON (B/M, 01/16/86), of a customer who was placing merchandise straight from the isles inside plastic shopping bags and placing them inside the cart. Prior to paying for the merchandise, the subject was obtaining the Walmart plastic bags from inside her shirt, from her breast area. The subject was initially seen at approximately 6:45 p.m.

The subject was later identified as Marquitte M. MILLER (b/f,7-20-90). MILLER proceeded to a register with the cart full of merchandise where she only paid for one item that she was holding. MILLER proceeded through the last point of purchase without paying for the merchandise that was located inside the cart. MILLER was accompanied by her son, who she verbally identified as Colby L. HERRON (b/m, 1/15/15) at a later time.

At approximately 7:15 p.m., MILLER was stopped by JOHNSON at the exit door, where MILLER attempted to walk away after advising JOHNSON that he could have everything back. I detained MILLER after she became uncooperative and refused to go to the Asset Protection Office. MILLER was escorted to the AP's office. MILLER identified herself verbally as Marquitte MILLER (b/f, 7-20-90). JOHNSON search the name in Walmart's records and discovered that MILLER was trespassed for retail theft. Upon arrival, Officers located the security officer inside of the Walmart store. He walked us over to the money center location where they had the victim identified as Cortez D BRASSEL (B/M 01-11-1995) sitting in a chair. I observed the B/M wearing a blue sweater, khaki pants, and black shoes. His face was covered with dried up blood, and there was a two-inch laceration on the lid of his right eye, and it was severely swollen. BRASSEL stated that he met a female on Facebook approximately three weeks ago and they met up with her for the first time today. BRASSEL stated that he and the female who he only knows by her Facebook name, QC goblowdat.

BRASSEL stated that he and QC met up at his aunt's house first and then they took an Uber to Walmart because he stated he needed some things. BRASSEL stated that QC expressed how she needed a few items also. He stated that once he was inside the store, he tried to get money from the ATM, and it stated that he had reached his limit for the day. He stated that he explained to QC that he could not get any money, and this is when he stated that QC's attitude changed. He stated QC began asking people around the store if they had PayPal. He stated that QC told him that she was not leaving until he gave her some money. BRASSEL stated that QC started making him feel uncomfortable, so he walked out of Walmart. He stated QC started to follow him. He stated he heard QC on the phone talking to someone, but he did not know who. He stated that he walked into the middle of the street, on Capital Drive. He stated QC ran up to him and started punching him. He stated that 3 black males then drove up and they all started punching and kicking him. He stated that he never really saw the males because it happened fast. He stated that QC then grabbed a knife and attempted to cut him, but a passerby stopped him. BRASSEL stated that it was a lot of cars that stopped to try to help him. BRASSEL stated that he was lying on his stomach when he felt one of the suspects grab his wallet out of his back pocket.

BRASSEL was later transported to St. Mary's hospital. As officers continued to investigate, BRASSEL expressed that he did not wish to prosecute. He stated that because he locked his cards and reported the theft, the suspects can't get access to his funds and that is all he was worried about. I gave BRASSEL a contact card and PV-17.

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller, Mohammed WEGDAN, who spoke broken english. WEGDAN stated that he was robbed and that someone stole his bananas. I then entered the security office and reviewed the footage of the incident in question. The footage depicted WEGDAN, leaving the store with a shopping cart and a box of bananas. A black male is observed leaving the store on the grocery side of the store at the same time as WEGDAN, accompanied by a black female. At this point words between the unidentified black male and WEGDAN begin to be exchanged, at which time they begin to physically fight. The black male is then observed grabbing the bananas from WEGDAN's cart and walking away. The black male is then observed grabbing the bananas from WEGDAN denied saying anything to the black male subject, however it does appear that he is making statements to the black male as they are exiting the store. The conversation between WEGDAN and the other subject involved appeared to be mutual, as well as the fight.

I spoke with WEGDAN and he denied that he said anything to the subject before the fight started. The black male is then observed leaving the area on foot with the female he was walking with. WEGDAN stated that he was not injured during the incident.

None of the employees of the store or security team witnessed the incident. I informed the manager that I would be filing this report regarding this incident. The store staff and security were cooperative during my investigation and provided me with security footage of the incident.

ROBERTS said that's when HILL struck him in the face with a closed fist and throw him to the ground. ROBERTS did stated HILL did choke him but it did not impede his breathing. ROBERTS did say he was in pain and has asthma.

It should be noted that HILL is approximately 5'10" 178lbs while ROBERTS is 5'06" 119lbs.
