

Enclosed please find a proposed resolution. We ask that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant alleges that his jewelry went missing after Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) responded to his 911 call for a health emergency regarding his wife on November 5, 2024. He alleges that since MFD staff were in the room where the jewelry was kept, they are responsible for taking the missing jewelry.

Our investigation revealed that on December 17, 2024, MFD received a complaint of missing jewelry regarding the 911 visit on November 5, 2024. MFD immediately launched an investigation into the alleged incident. The MFD Captain present during the aforementioned 911 call reported that neither he or any staff involved have any recollection of the patient's jewelry or any other personal effects belonging to the patient. In addition, he noted that the crew involved provided exemplary treatment to the patient in a critical situation.

There is no evidence that the City of Milwaukee is liable for damages in this case. Therefore, we recommend that his claim submitted by Lawrence Scott Schneiderman in the amount of \$7,670.00 be denied.
