Subject: Street Lighting
Mitchell Interchange Reconstruction
Phase I

Dear Council Members:

Reconstruction of the Mitchell Interchange will include modifications to local streets. Due to the magnitude of this project, it is being divided into phases. This first phase will affect the area including West College Avenue from South 20th Street to South 13th Street, the intersection of South 6th Street and West Bolivar Avenue and the East side of South 27th Street from West Layton Avenue to West Bottsford Avenue and adjoining streets.

Street lighting facility modifications being done in conjunction with this project will include installation of interim lighting, installation of permanent lighting improvements, and the removal of the interim lighting in the above-named area. Funding for the street lighting work is provided by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) by means of a Local Force Account (LFA) contract.

One hundred percent of the total cost will be funded by WISDOT.

The attached resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an LFA contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install the interim lighting, permanent lighting improvements, and removal of the interim lighting in conjunction with the work in the above named areas.
