File #011344 is a substitute ordinance relative to optional life insurance.

## **Background**

- 1. The Common Council adopted Sec. 350-25-4-b-4 of the Milwaukee City Code which authorized employees represented by certain unions to apply for optional supplemental life insurance coverage in increments of \$1,000 up to a maximum of either 1.5 times his/her basic salary or \$100,000, whichever is greater.
- 2. On January 22, 2002, the Common Council approved Resolution #000983 that ratified and confirmed the final agreement between the City of Milwaukee and Public Union Local #61,LIUNA, AFL-CIO/CLC. The agreement covers wages, hours and conditions of employment for the period of January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2002. Local 61 represents approximately 350 city employees.
- 3. The agreement included a provision that allows members of Local 61 to purchase supplemental life insurance coverage under the terms and conditions set forth by Sec. 350-25-b-4 of the Milwaukee Code.

## **Discussion**

1. The substitute ordinance adds the members of Local and Public Union Local #61,LIUNA, AFL-CIO/CLC to the list of employees eligible to purchase optional life insurance coverage.

## Fiscal Impact

The ordinance has no fiscal impact. The life insurance coverage is voluntary and paid for by the employee.
