Resolution recognizing Brad “Scarface” Jordan on his participation in the 2019 Hip-Hop Week MKE on August 24, 2019.

WHEREAS,

BRAD “SCARFACE” JORDAN

was recognized for his distinguished participation in the 2019 Hip-Hop Week MKE during two special events on August 24, 2019 at the Wisconsin Black Historical Society, 2620 W. Center St. and at The Rave, 2401 W. Wisconsin Ave.; and

***WHEREAS,** Brad “Scarface” Jordan, a former rapper and record producer, and current candidate for the City of Houston’s City Council, hosted the Hip-Hop Goes To the Polls event at the Wisconsin Black Historical Society at 2620 W. Center St. and was honored at the Hip-Hop Legacy Awards Show and Concert at The Rave, 2401 W. Wisconsin Ave. during the Hip-Hop Week MKE run during August 2019; and*

***WHEREAS,** Scarface founded the Positive Purpose Movement, an organization that creates and supports programs for the education, enrichment, and empowerment of underrepresented communities in Houston, and the Positive Purpose Movement does this through its aims to benefit those underrepresented communities and remedy obstacles which may prevent them from being successful, productive citizens; and*

***WHEREAS,** As of June 2019, Scarface launched his campaign to be elected as councilperson for District D within the Houston City Council, and his campaign seeks to “put the neighbor back in the hood,” a motto which helped found the Positive Purpose Movement; and*

***WHEREAS,** Scarface’s political seminar successfully dived into conversation regarding the topics of Hip-Hop and politics, speaking to the importance of voting and the political field in regard to the Hip-Hop community; now, therefore, be it*

***RESOLVED,** That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes Brad “Scarface” Jordan for his valuable contributions to the 2019 Hip-Hop Week MKE and extends for him its sincere wishes for continued success and happiness; and, be it*
