
REASON FOR REQUEST:

David Letteer, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a marked police squad car that was stopped facing eastbound at the intersection of West Capital Drive and North Second Street with another car stopped behind the squad. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling eastbound on West Capital Drive at a high rate of speed, failed to stop and struck the driver side of the other vehicle and then rear-ended the squad car, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Letteer sustained injuries to his head, neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$6,496.00.
