Common Council File 061117 is a resolution to extend an agreement between the Milwaukee County Automated Mapping and Land Information System (MCAMLIS) Steering Committee and the Department of Administration (DOA) for an additional six months. MCAMLIS is reimbursing the City for services provided through this agreement.

Common Council File 051467 was adopted to authorize DOA to enter into an agreement with the MCAMLIS Steering Committee for professional and technical services in the maintenance of cadastral maps and street address database. The agreement obligates the DOA Information and Technology Management Division (ITMD) to maintain and update cadastral maps and map data in a format consistent with that used by MCAMLIS. To perform this function, ITMD required authority for one new position, a GIS Analyst, with the position funded entirely from revenues received from MCAMLIS. The original agreement provided for MCAMLIS to pay the city \$74,915 for services from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

File 061117 authorizes DOA to enter into a similar agreement for the period from July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007. MCAMLIS will pay up to \$35,258 for services provided through this new agreement. The GIS Analyst position will continue to provide services and will be reimbursed by MCAMLIS. The position will be footnoted to have position authority expire December 31, 2007 unless the MCAMLIS agreement is extended. There is no fiscal impact to the city.

Entering into this agreement will ensure that both the city and Milwaukee County maintain cadastral maps and store data using the standard MCAMLIS geodatabase format. This will not only facilitate intergovernmental sharing of date, it will also enhance the capabilities of city applications, including MapMilwaukee and COMPASS, by providing more timely access to updated and consistent information.
