AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY OF uMHLATHUZE (SOUTH AFRICA) AND THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE (U.S.A.)

Whereas, the Sister City Program, administered by Sister Cities International[®], was initiated by the President of the United States of America in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the United States and other nations through direct personal contact; and

Whereas, in order to foster those goals, the people of Milwaukee and uMhlathuze in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring educational, economic and cultural opportunities; and

Whereas, we agree to support and encourage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of business, culture, health care, education and tourism; and

Whereas, uMhlathuze and Milwaukee, sharing a common interest in education, health care and business, and the desire to promote mutual understanding among our citizens do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities beginning on [City Clerk to insert date of adoption] the date of Milwaukee Common Council resolution establishing the Sister City relationship became effective;

Now Therefore, Milwaukee and uMhlathuze do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities, and declare their intent to abide by these guidelines according to Sister Cities International[®] policies.
