Attached is File No. 020091, being a resolution designating St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, 4001 South 68th Street, as an Historic District, in the 11th Aldermanic District.

This resolution finds that this district possesses integrity of location, architectural type, workmanship and association and fulfills four of the criteria included in Section 308-81(2)(e)

A public hearing was held on May 20, 2002 at which time a number of objections to the proposal were made and two persons spoke in favor of the nomination.

Based on its belief that the designation would have a positive impact on the district and the surrounding neighborhood and that many of the concerns about the cost of expanding and updating the church facilities could be achieved by working with the Historic Preservation Commission, the City Plan Commission at its regular meeting on May 20, 2002 recommended that the resolution be approved.
